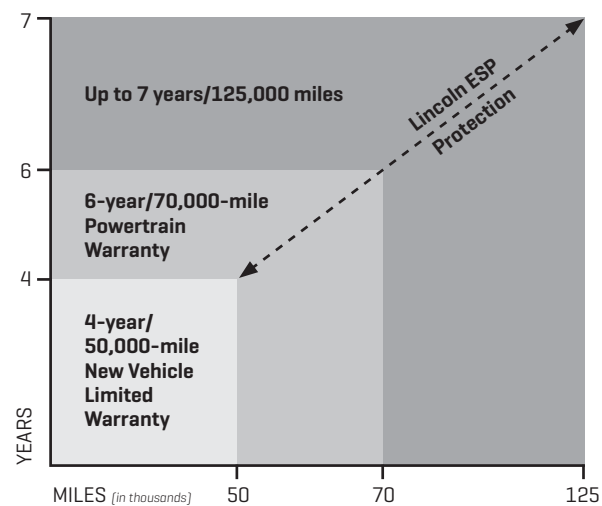

For New Plans:

- Coverage begins with the original in-service date [New Vehicle Limited Warranty start date] and zero miles. Coverage expires upon reaching your selected time, mileage or hours, whichever occurs first.

For Used Plans:

- Coverage for Ford, Lincoln and Mercury vehicles beyond the New Vehicle Limited Warranty and all competitive-make vehicles begins at the signature date and current mileage and expires upon reaching your selected time or mileage, whichever occurs first.
- Eligible Ford, Lincoln and Mercury vehicles that have New Vehicle Limited Warranty remaining at the time of purchase – coverage begins at the signature date and current mileage/hours. Coverage ends at the earlier of the number of months purchased or the number of miles/hours purchased from the expiration of the New Vehicle Limited Warranty.
