For a mere \$30 at the door, you can enjoy some of the area's most talented jazz musicians – like the long-standing sensation Bob Sneider Trio, or new-on-the-scene Uptown Groove – eat chef-prepared hors d'oeuvres, dinner and dessert, and take in the inspiring, eclectic atmosphere of Artisan Works.

In addition to experiencing an evening of culture and fun, it's also a great way for you to give back to the Rochester art community. Ticket proceeds help support radio station Jazz 90.1 FM, while live and silent auction proceeds go to Rochester's, Artisan Works.

The live auction features hand-selected pieces from the Artisan Works galleries ranging from hundreds to thousands of dollars in value, while the silent auction offers prizes like a ride on the Esperanza Rose or an overnight package for two at a quaint Finger Lakes Bed and Breakfast.

"Last year's event brought about 250 people out, but this year we're hoping for more. I always tell people, Artisan Works is constantly changing. So if you think you've seen it all, come back and look again," said radio station Jazz 90.1 manager and event organizer, Rob Linton.
