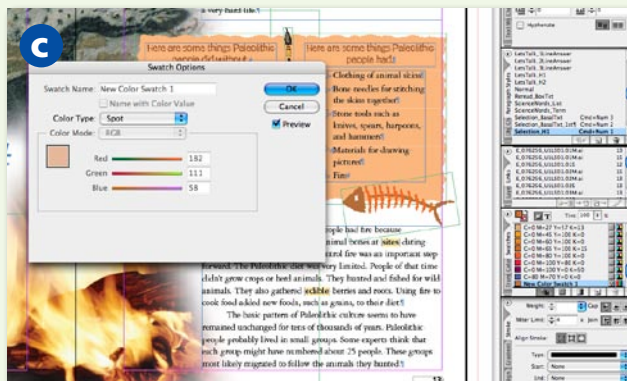
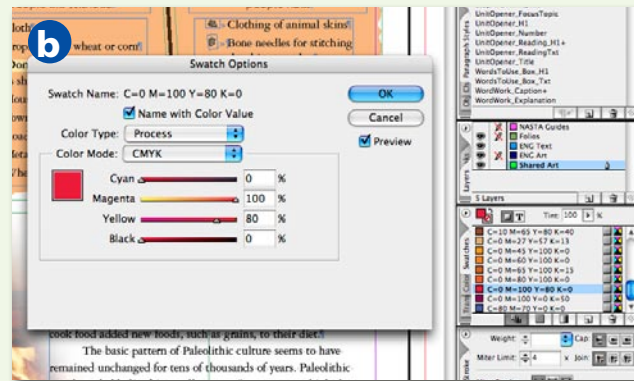
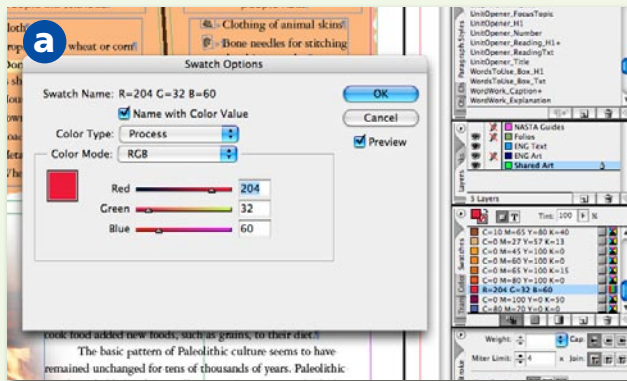
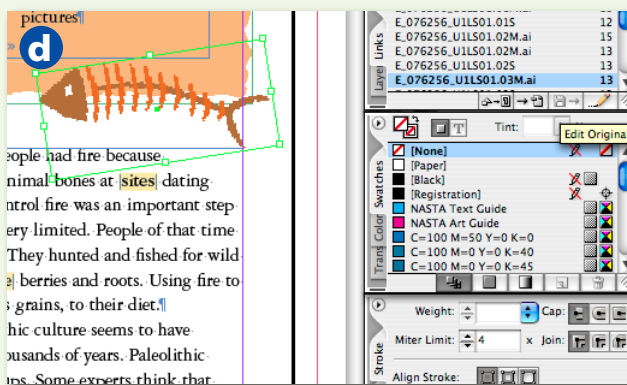


## 2. Make sure all color swatches are CMYK Process, not RGB, Spot, or Duotone.

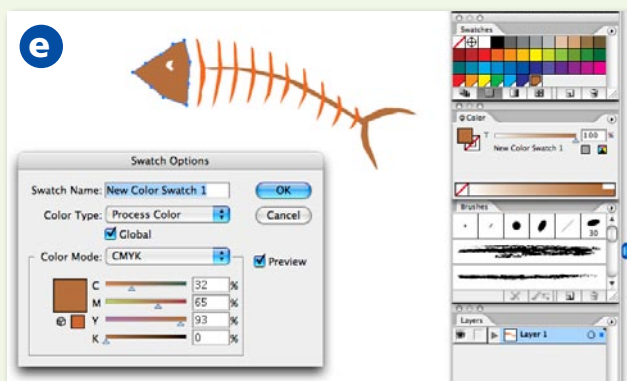
Check the Swatches palette. Delete all unused colors (from the pop-up menu). If any colors are RGB, Spot, or Duotone, convert them to CMYK Process in Swatch Options.



If there's a grayed out RGB, Spot or Duotone swatch that can't be deleted or edited...



Open the image by clicking on the Pencil icon (Edit Original) in the Links palette.



Open the swatch menu in Illustrator to change the color to CMYK. (or in Photoshop, change the color channel mode to CMYK).

Save and close the image, then return to InDesign. The image will be automatically updated in the Links palette and the unused color swatch can then be deleted.
