The intent of the competition was to have future healthcare designers build their knowledge of the evidence-based design process and know how to utilize it to create better spaces that support healing and well-being for patients, families, and staff. The project was completed in a cross-class collaboration with the Interior Design department. Each team designed a healthcare environment, in this case a pediatrics waiting room, utilizing the eight step EBD process. The waiting room design is comprised of groups of cells, much like in the human body, that allows freedom of choice for parents, easy maintenance for staff, and a pleasant experience for children.
