## Shower Touch Saving Water For Tomorrow With Awareness Today.



The Casing of the Shower touch would be manufactured with three separate pieces and incorporate two splitlines. When packaged the middle section and front section would already be assembled but they would not be fixed to the back section allowing the user/ plumber to construct any additional piping to the mains required. This also allows the back of the shower Touch to be screwed to the wall.



The back of the casing is white, Injection Moulded, Recyclable ABS and screws into the wall of the desired location. The back also fixes all the components into correct positioning.



All the componants apart from the monitor fix to the back piece.



The mid piece of the casing is white, Injection Moulded, recyclable ABS and attaches to the back piece. The monitor rests on it to allow it to be attached to the front piece. The mid piece first screws into the front piece to secure the monitor into position and is then screwed to the back piece.

The front piece of the casing is sand casted, chrome plated steel. The front piece positions the monitor into place and is attached to the mid piece.
