GOLF - EAST COURSE - \$247 per participant, Includes a box lunch.

The East Course is known for its wide fairways and large greens. With tree-lined fairways and amazing mountain views, The Broadmoor East Course is ranked among the best in the country. With large trees that can alter your shots, and putting greens that can be difficult to read, the best tip we can offer for this open course is to remember that putts break away from the mountains. The East Course was one of only 12 North American and Caribbean golf courses to receive a five-star rating by Golf Digest. Club and shoe rental available for additional cost.

FLY FISHING -PRICE TBD - Includes a box lunch and transportation.

Guided fly-fishing trips are appropriate for both the experienced angler and people who are new to the sport. Experienced guides provide complete instruction as appropriate for your level of experience or request. Catch and Release is practiced on all guided fishing trips. You will need to bring layers of clothing including a rain jacket, a brimmed ball-cap or hat, polarized sunglasses, and sunscreen. The sunglasses are essential for eye protection. Fishing locations on the South Platte River range from 7,000 to 8,500 feet in elevation, so be prepared for cooler temperatures and rain showers.

HOT AIR BALLOON RIDE - \$342 per participant

Take a hot air balloon ride and enjoy the spectacular views of the Colorado Rocky Mountains, from the Spanish Peaks on the New Mexico border to Longs Peak west of Denver. Each hour-long flight is a unique journey guided by the winds and the skill of your pilot. A champagne toast, a continental breakfast and presentation of the first flight certificate follow your flight. This daily adventure begins at dawn and returns 3 - 4 hours later, depending on the launch site.
