Lucas Corso, middle aged, tired, and cynical, is a book detective, a mercenary hired to hunt down rare editions for wealthy and unscrupulous clients. When a well-known bibliophile is found hanged, leaving behind part of the original manuscript of Alexandre Dumas's The Three Musketeers, Corso is brouhgt in to authenticate the fragments.

The task seems straightforward, but the unsuspecting Corso is soon drawn into a swirling plot involving devil worship, occult practices, and swahbuckling derring-do among a cast of characters bearing a supicious resemblance to those of Dumas's masterpiece. Aided by a mysterious beauty named for a Conan Doyle heroine, Corso travles from Madrid to Toledo tp Paris in pursuit of a sinister ans seemingly omniscient killer. Part mystery, part puzzle, part witty intertexual game, The Dumas Club is a wholly original intellectual thriller by the internationally bestselling author of The Flanders Panel and The Seville Communion.
