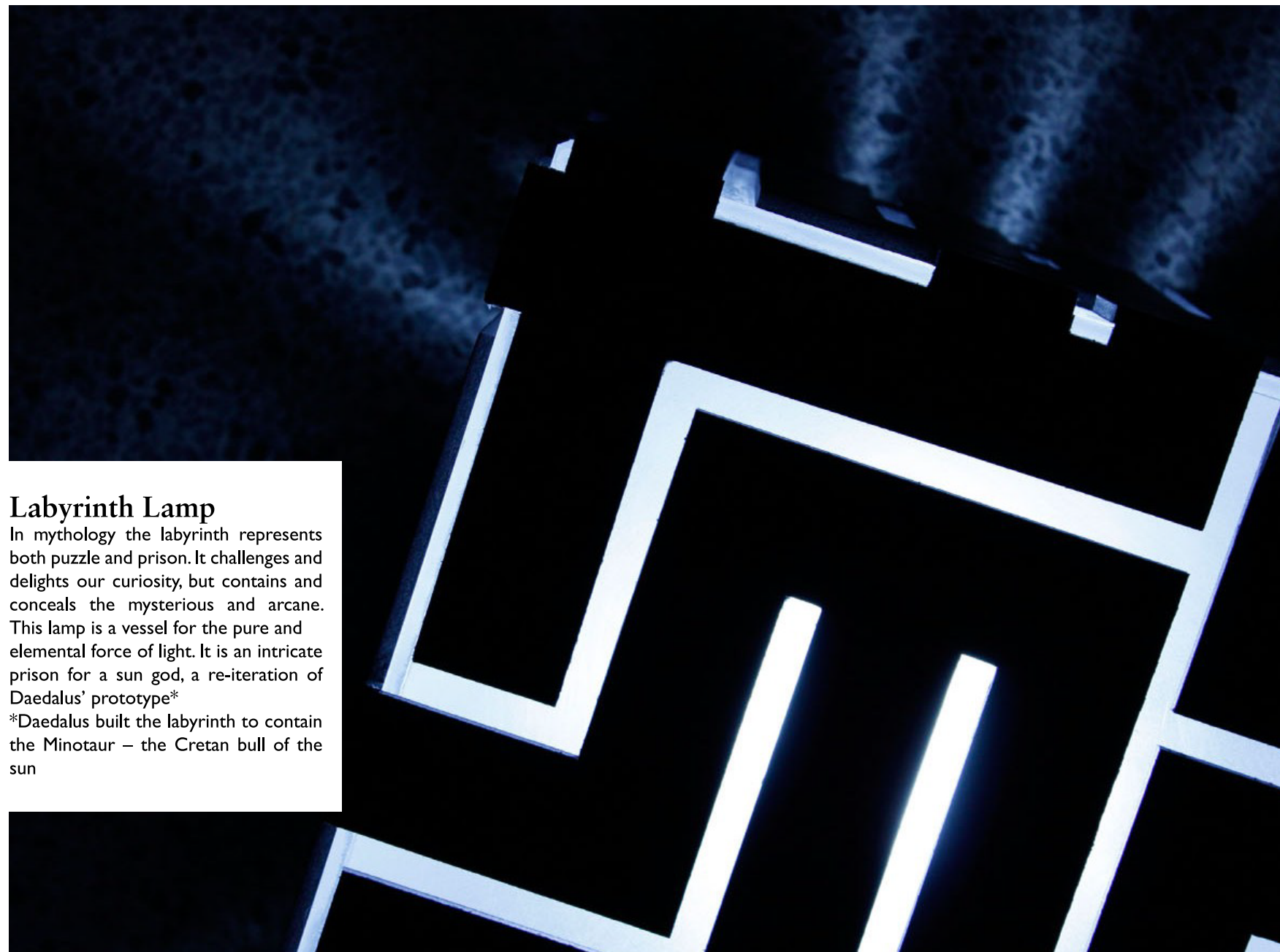


LABYRINTH LAMP

A Vessel for the Pure & Elemental Force of Light



Labyrinth Lamp

In mythology the labyrinth represents both puzzle and prison. It challenges and delights our curiosity, but contains and conceals the mysterious and arcane. This lamp is a vessel for the pure and elemental force of light. It is an intricate prison for a sun god, a re-iteration of Daedalus' prototype*

*Daedalus built the labyrinth to contain the Minotaur – the Cretan bull of the sun



The original prototype (pictured) for the Labyrinth Lamp measured 1'x 1'x 1' and was crafted out of black foamcore and clear acrylic. It was illuminated using a CFL light bulb. A refined model (next page) measuring 6"x 6"x 6" was crafted using black acrylic on clear acrylic with a turned aluminum base. It was illuminated using a high powered LED. The Labyrinth was inspired by the pure form of a perfect cube and the contrast between light and dark.
