



# Too Much Is NEVER Enough

*Piling it on has never been more popular and Sydney Evan gives a lesson in layering. So easy! So chic!*

The word “party” has been co-opted in jewelry to refer to wearing many pieces at once and no other jewelry range is better suited to this trend than personalization-happy Sydney Evan.

The days of wearing just gold or just silver are passé. Have more than one of something? Smoothly mix your metals by giving necklaces a similar theme. Here we showed Sydney Evan’s most-recognized piece, the Love collection, tiered gently one above the other. Who doesn’t want an abundance of love?

Start with a blend of beaded bracelets and throw in a bangle or a leather wrap for textural interest. We went tonal with blue and rose gold bracelets to give a sense of unity. And finished it off with a Bollywood-inspired chain bracelet to make it pop.

Nothing says day to night like adding an ear jacket (a little dangle that goes onto the post of your earring in the front). The spike in this look makes for a quick transition and can be added (or removed) from any post earring. Wondering if you can rock an ear cuff? Give it a soft feel as we’ve done here by picking one in delicate diamonds or pairing it with small dainty elements.

Just because your necklace came on one chain doesn’t mean you’re married to it! Try swapping out different types of chains and mixing up lengths to allow each necklace to pop as we’ve done here, showcasing the heart, butterfly and starburst medallion to full effect.
