

## Ages 8 - 13 Year Olds

**B**oys and girls ages 8-13 are placed in separate groups. There are 12 campers and one head group leader in each group. **All group leaders are college students.** Campers are grouped by the grade they are entering in the fall. At each scheduled activity, there are at least one to two additional activity staff members. Thus, making the ratio of campers to staff, 4:1.

Each week is a new schedule and a different theme with fun-filled events correlated to the week's theme. **Entertainment days are usually every Friday and are also theme based.** The wide range of activities that groups of these ages will experience at Kiwi include: Instructional and recreational swim (American Red Cross Instruction in four state-of-the-art, heated pools). Beach, splash (waterslides), boating, all sports, state-of-the-art batting cages, mini-golf, recreational games, wilderness adventure (with zip lines), climbing wall, arcade, nature, music, dance arts & crafts, jewelry making, and much, much more.

Prior to the camp season, Kiwi has a "meet and greet". Parents bring their children to meet the Kiwi staff. At this time, we give out Kiwi shirts. Campers are asked to wear their Kiwi shirt every Monday. Each group is color coded, so that we are able to identify their age quickly, every Monday, at arrival.
