

... Bevel is sofa, a table, a chair, a bed, a children's fort. It is not a piece of furniture but a system by which to make furniture. One **elemental form**, inspired by the angles of the **hexagon**, is paired, combined, and reconfigured per the user's needs and whims. The modern convertible sofa, clunky and rigid, rarely sees a non-static life, but Bevel's soft, lightweight structure encourages fun, everyday rearrangements. Parts are playfully connected by slim magnets embedded in the foam and thin tubular supports reinforce the shape. The 120 degree angles found throughout the design serve the body in a variety of ways: providing lower back support in a lounge function, continuous back support as a gaming chair and space for your feet and legs as a table. Cup-holders and finger grips are carved shallowly into the foam and add a decorative layer. ...

Whether you are five or twenty-five, a pair or a group, Bevel transforms to suite your lifestyle. It's a futon in your dorm room, a table at a cocktail party, a seat on the floor. Bevel is endless potential with the simplest vocabulary.
