Harmony Caponio



### Former foster youth rises above her past and succeeds

Harmony Caponio has had enough traumatic experiences for a lifetime including witnessing domestic violence, entering foster care at nine and becoming a high school dropout. Choosing to rise above it all, she has put her life together.

Harmony speaks openly about her experiences in foster youth, exiting an abusive relationship, and being a teen mother. She landed at SRJC during a stressful time - working two jobs, and couch-surfing with her daughter. "I found a card, it said SRJC Foster & Kinship Care Education - Nick Lawrence - so I called. I didn't even know how to enroll. When I came to SRJC, I got stability, inspiration and landed a job."

The stability was short-lived. She dropped out and grieved after the unexpected loss of her son at birth, and the loss of her partner. "I'd been through a lot, bounced back, but never experienced death... there's a spiritual presence... During that time I was finding a new me, faith, hope... it transformed me," says Harmony.

With determination, she returned to take an inspiring media class, leading Harmony to double major, earn a 4.0 GPA, receive a scholarship, and discover CalWORKS. Today, she strives for good grades, gives speeches about her experiences, provides for her daughter, and proceeds towards her degree.
