Supportive Living Program

This program is geared toward people who are transitioning from group homes or lengthy hospitalizations and have achieved a relative level of independent living skills. A limited supply of scatter-site, agency-owned housing is available for this program.

Advance Consumer Choice and Empowerment Program (ACCEP)

This program is an option to group home placement for people ready for discharge from Greystone Park Psychiatric hospital who are choosing to live in more independent situations. Services are provided by a residential intensive support team capable of meeting the consumers' needs in the community 24 hours a day.

Aging out Youth Program

The Aging Out Youth Program provides permanent supportive housing services to youth aging out of the Department of Children and Family services and transitioning to the adult mental health system. Consumers will work closely with a Youth Transition Specialist and a multidisciplinary team to ensure normalized living arrangements coupled with individualized services. Staff members provide a flexible and responsive system of support that allows consumers to maintain independence and a lifestyle of their choosing.

The Homeless Service Team

This program uses a holistic approach to help homeless adults with psychiatric disabilities achieve a better quality of life. The Host team uses the Housing First model to move people from the streets and shelters to the safety of their own homes. The staff are accessible 24 hours a day, 365 days a year.

History of Advance Housing

Advance Housing, Inc. was started by a consortium of mental health providers in order to meet the growing need for supporting housing services. In 1997, the agency opened its doors with funding from the Division of Mental Health Services (DMHS) to provide consumers an array of individualized support services coupled with affordable and normalizing living arrangements. Since then, the agency has received funding from various public and private sources, to maintain and expand its programs throughout northern new jersey.

Staffing and Hours

Each program is staffed with a multidisciplinary team in order to meet the diverse needs of consumers. The staff includes license professionals, Master's level professionals, social services staff, peer counselors, nurses, a psychiatrist, and property management staff. Consumers needs are met 24 hours a day.
