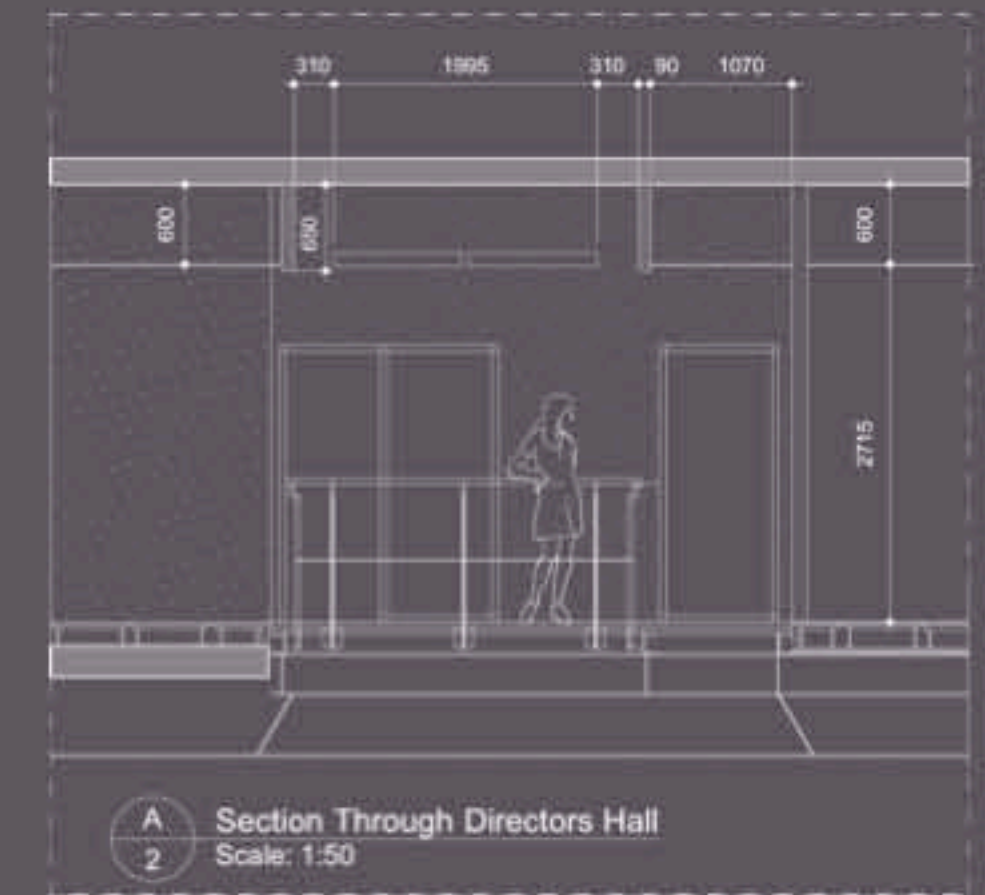
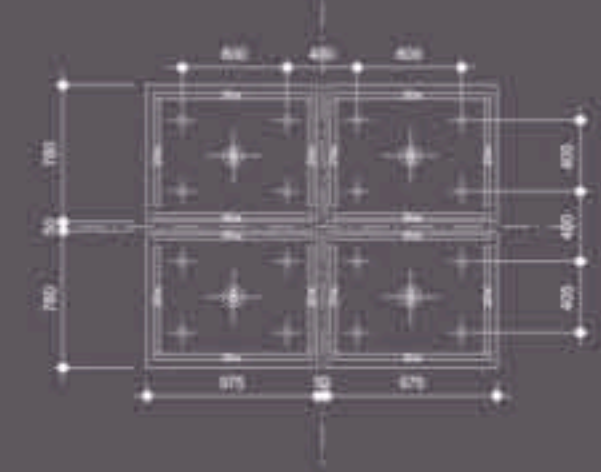
Observing the client's appreciation for greenery, the design offered plenty of support for plants.



Workgroup cluster view – Large table for 6 people with a garden in the middle



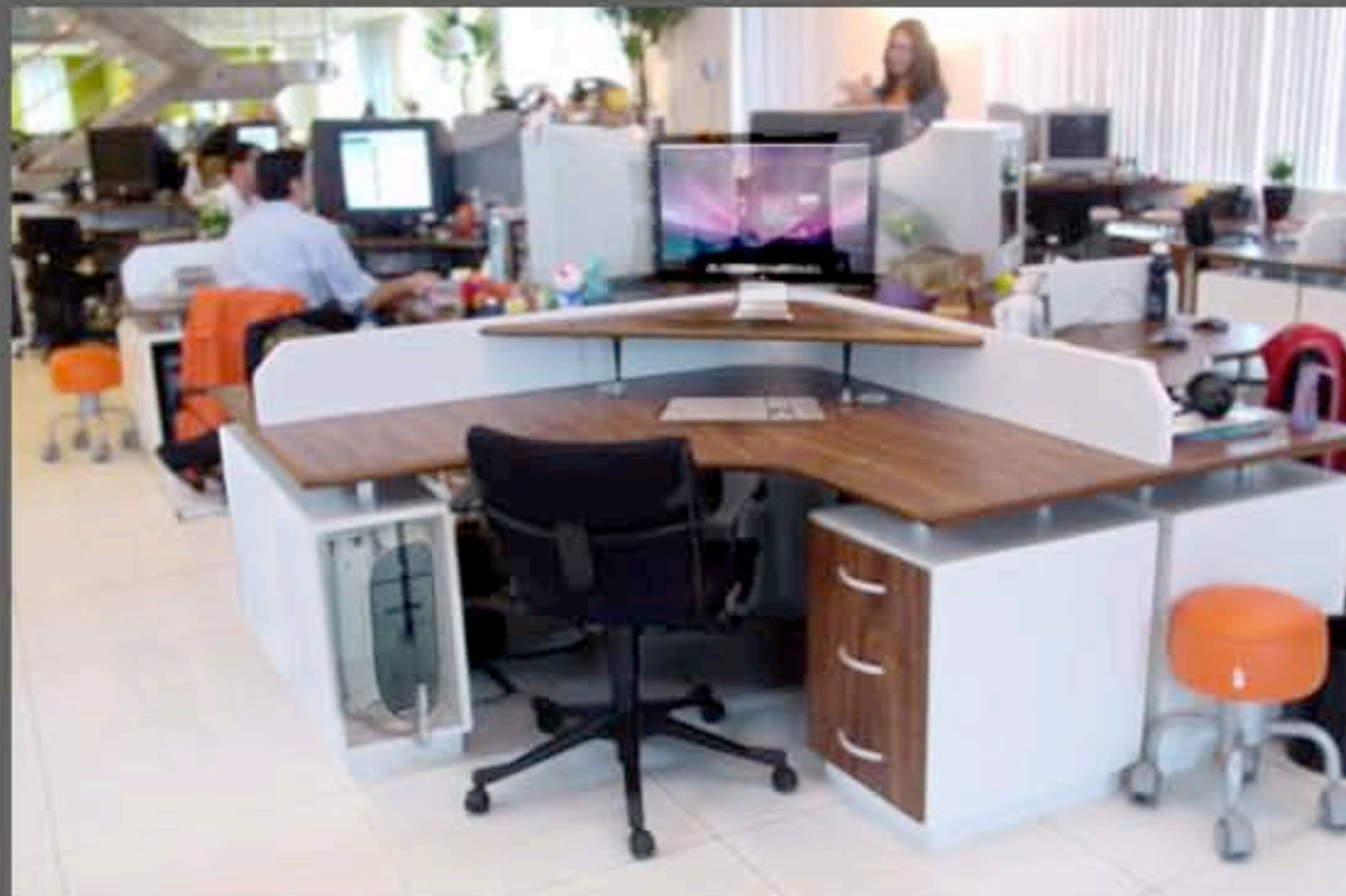
Director's distribution hall – The other double height area between the 9th and 10th floor



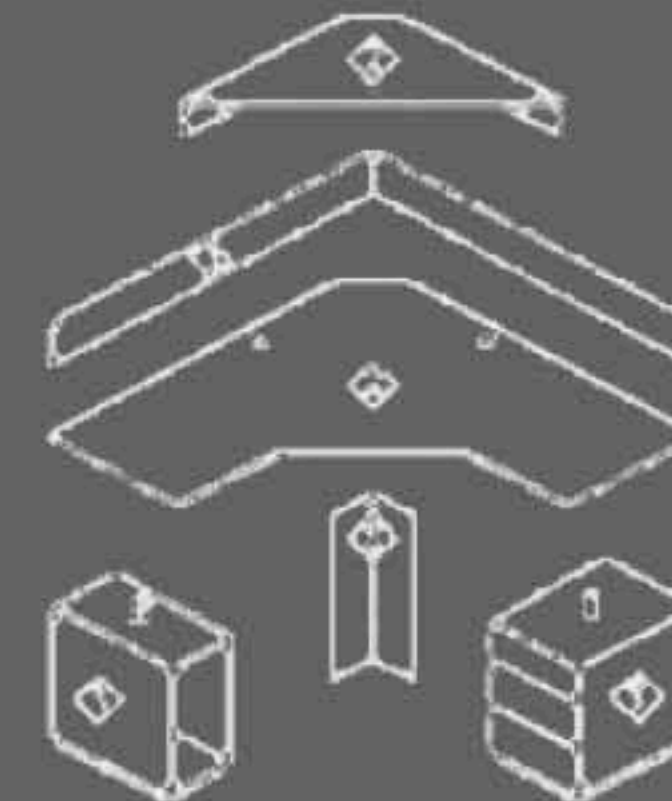
Suspended ceilings - detail and section
