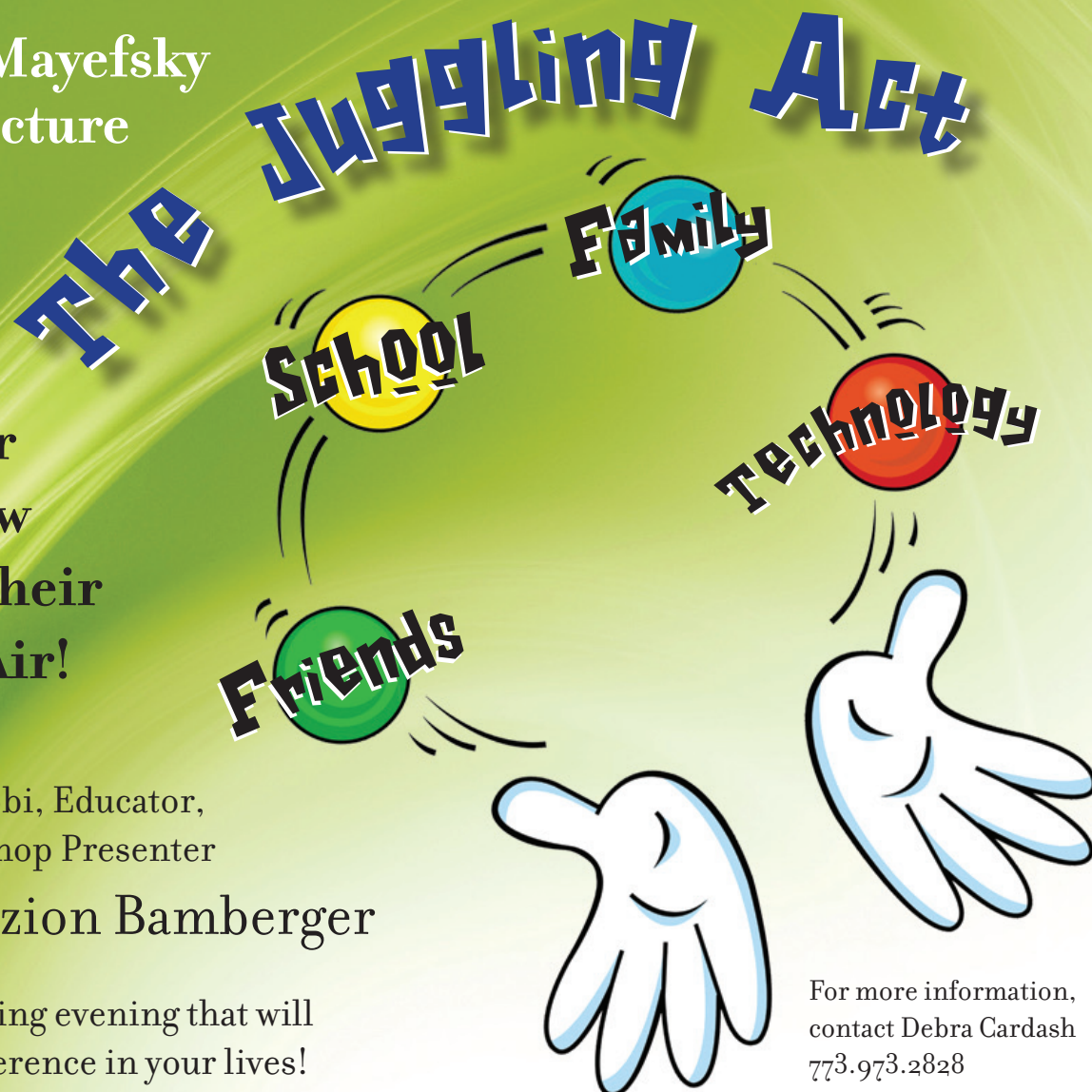

Rabbi Bamberger

Rabbi Bamberger was born in London, England. He is a Musmach of Yeshivas Be'er Yaakov, and was a close talmid of Rav Shlomo Wolbe, zt"l. Rav Bamberger received Smicha from Rav Moshe Shmuel Shapiro, zt"l and Rav Yaakov Fink. After his marriage, Rav Bamberger continued learning in Yeshivas Mir Yerushalayim. Concurrently he received additional Smichos in specific areas from Rav Yehoshua Neuwirth, Shlita, and Rav Zalman Nechemia Goldberg, Shlita. Rav Bamberger has taught every grade from 3rd through Beis Medrash, as well as girls in Seminary. He was also a Maggid Shiur and Mashgiach Ruchani in Yeshivas Beis Yisroel in Israel.

For the past 12 years, Rav Bamberger and his family have been living in New York. Rav Bamberger led the Beis Hamedrash of Flatbush for nine years, while also serving as the Rosh Hayeshiva and ninth grade Rebbe of Yeshivas Ohavei Torah of Riverdale. Currently, Rav Bamberger lives in Monsey and is the Mashgiach Ruchani and ninth grade Rebbe at Yeshivas Ohr Reuven and Rav of Kehilla Kedoshah Yad Halevi. He is a guest lecturer at Ohr Esther, a night seminary in Monsey.
