The Bergamot teapot consists of five pieces all friction fit. Removing the upper lid reveals the steel mesh basket for holding the loose leaf tea, which can be easily removed for cleaning. The handle is made of thermoset plastic melamine and secured to the glass body by means of circular protrusions that align with holes in the handle part. This allows the handle to remain fixed though it appears it may easily slide off when lifted.

The cups are similarly friction fit with melamine handles on glass, although as they have parallel sides, they do not have protrusions, instead they have a ribbed silicon rubber layer to maintain the friction even when wet.
