WHEN TO CALL THE LACTATION CONSULTANT FOR HELP:

BEFORE THE BABY IS BORN, CALL IF:

- 1. You have flat or inverted nipples.
- 2. You tried to nurse before but had problems.
- 3. You have had any type of breast surgery.
- 4. You have questions about any aspect of breastfeeding.

AFTER THE BABY IS BORN, CALL IF:

- 1. Your baby is not latching-on or is not nursing well within 48-72 hours.
- 2. Born preterm between 35–38 weeks.
- 3. You are engorged or having nipple pain longer than 48 hours. Breastfeeding is NOT supposed to HURT!!!

- 4. Your baby is not having at least TWO (2) yellow bowel movements after the fourth day, in each 24-hour period.
- 5. Your baby is sleepy and hard to wake-up, or the feedings are less than 8 times in a 24 hour period.
- 6. You feel that your milk supply is low.
- 7. Your baby is NOT gaining weight or is a slow weight gainer.
- 8. You have a plugged duct or red area on your breast.
- 9. You intend to return to work or school.
- 10. You have TWO (2) bad feeds in a row.
- 11. There are special circumstances such as:
 - Labor or Delivery complications
 - Bottle fed at the hospital
 - Jaundice
 - Premature infant
 - Cleft/lip palate
 - Neurological Problems
