

Traveling position- This position is used to keep extra rods out of the way while paddling to different locations.

Drifting bait/tackle management- This position allows the angler to control bait rig easily, while keeping the rod close for maintenance and changing lures.

Trolling- This position allows for uninterrupted paddling while keeping the rod within reach.

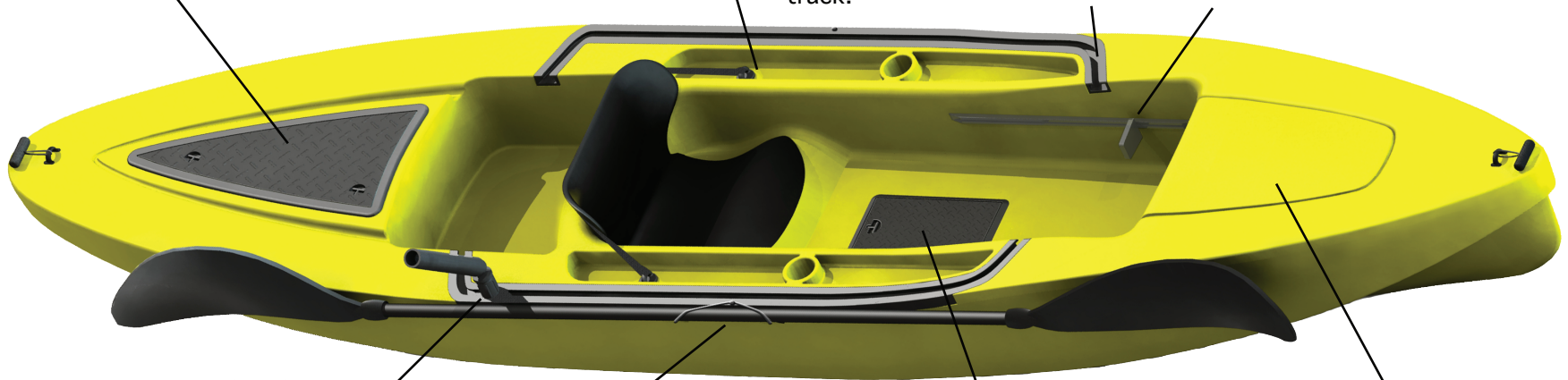


Large dry hatch for storage of gear, i.e. extra clothes & camping gear.

Integrated tackle trays with tie points to keep tools from going overboard.

The Rapid Rail System is on both sides for maximum versatility. Accessories can be mounted and removed by sliding in and out of the track.

Adjustable foot rests eliminate the need for foot ridges. The flat floor provides a standing area for flat water sight fishing.



Rapid Rail modules are highly adaptable and move with a quick twist of the base knob.

Paddle keeper eases paddle management while drifting or transporting.

The Center hatch houses a sliding tray for tackle organizers. It can be pushed back under the seat for extra storage.

Front hatch holds removable cooler tray for fish, food, or general storage.
