Round trip for adults is as low as \$4.00. (prices are based on traveling on off-peak trains).

**LIRR Escort** can meet your group at your home station and accompany you into Penn Station. We will even reserve space in a

train car for your group.

**Subway** Discount with the purchase of 30 subway tickets or more – you will save 25% on MetroCards. If your group contains 60 members or more you can have a subway escort.

**Return Any Time** which includes return travel on peak trains. Group members may return at different times all for as little as \$4.00 round trip per person.

**Train Travel vs Bus** which can cost \$1,000 and up for a group to and from Long Island. You can save up to 75% via the LIRR.
