- No social life

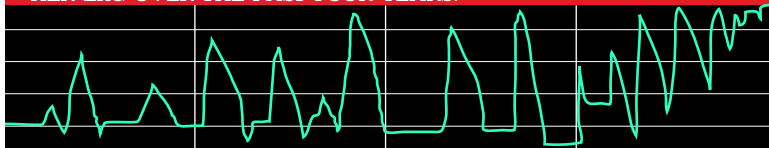
HER SYMPTOMS INCLUDE:
