I decided to focus on these three Marc Newson's furniture to understand the language on each piece.



In this picture, I observed an extruded "m" shape that curves with a pattern that lofts from big, to small, to big. Also, the body supports itself at the front, and there is only one leg supporting the back of the chair.



In this picture, I observed an extruded "v" shape with one wing on each side at the top. Next to the wings, two extruded circles that almost look like they are the joints of the "v" shape and the wings.



In this picture, I observed a cellular form as the body of the chair. Two front legs that perforate the chair's body on the top, coming from side to side, and a third leg supporting the back of the chair.
