Paper Recycling!!!

1. CORRUGATED BOXES

Corrugated Boxes and Kraft paper bags - Flatten the boxes and do not include plastics or Styrofoam, wet or food contaminated boxes.

DO NOT INCLUDE THESE

Wax Coated Cardboard, Feed / Seed Sacks, Food Encrusted Material, Beverage Boxes , (coated), Pop Carriers (coated), Chipboard (Examples : Cereal & Tissue Boxes.)

2. NEWSPAPERS

Recycle: Newspapers and Advertising Supplements

NOTE: Newspapers can be loose or tied with string. Supplements that come with the newspapers can stay with the newspapers when recycling.

Do Not Recycle: Magazines* / Catalogs, Phone Books*, Unwanted Residential Mail*, Envelopes* / Books, Cereal Boxes*

3. MAGAZINES

Recycle: Only slick or glossy magazines and catalogs accepted. Any shiny magazine like Time, Newsweek, and National Geographic. Any shiny magazine like Time, Newsweek, and National Geographic.

DO NOT INCLUDE THESE
TV Guides, Reader's Digest, Tabloids, Phone Books

Paper Recycling!!!

5. MIXED PAPER

Residential Mixed Paper consists of: Junk mail, catalogs, advertisers without plastic bags, paper bags, wrapping paper (dry & clean), office paper, office files, Beverage Boxes (coated), Pop Carriers (coated), chipboard boxes like cereal boxes or tissue boxes (flattened with liner removed),

DO NOT INCLUDE THESE

Wet or food contaminated paper, plastic, glass, aluminum.

Metal Recycling!!!

1. Aluminum

Include all aluminum cans.

DO NOT INCLUDE THESE

steel cans, glass, paper, corrugated, plastics and food.

2. Steel "Tin" Cans

Steel cans that are accepted for recycling are food cans, coffee, bottle tops and jam jar lids. (Remove any plastic caps).

DO NOT INCLUDE THESE

aluminum, glass, paper, corrugated, plastics and food.



Plastic Recycling!!!

Plastic Bottles

Check the neck, if it is smaller than the bottle, check the number if #1 or #2, remove the lid or pump, and flatten



Examples: Water bottles, soda bottles, kitchen items like catsup, juice, peanut butter, cooking oil, syrup.



Examples: Milk jugs, shampoo, conditioner, mouthwash, baby oil, liquid laundry detergent, spray cleaners, and bleach bottles.

DO NOT INCLUDE THESE

Yogurt or cottage cheese containers, caps, lids, or pumps, motor oil bottles, pesticides, or herbicide containers, margarine or butter tubs, foam cups, food trays, or egg cartons, microwave food trays, bags or stretch wrap, toys or buckets.
