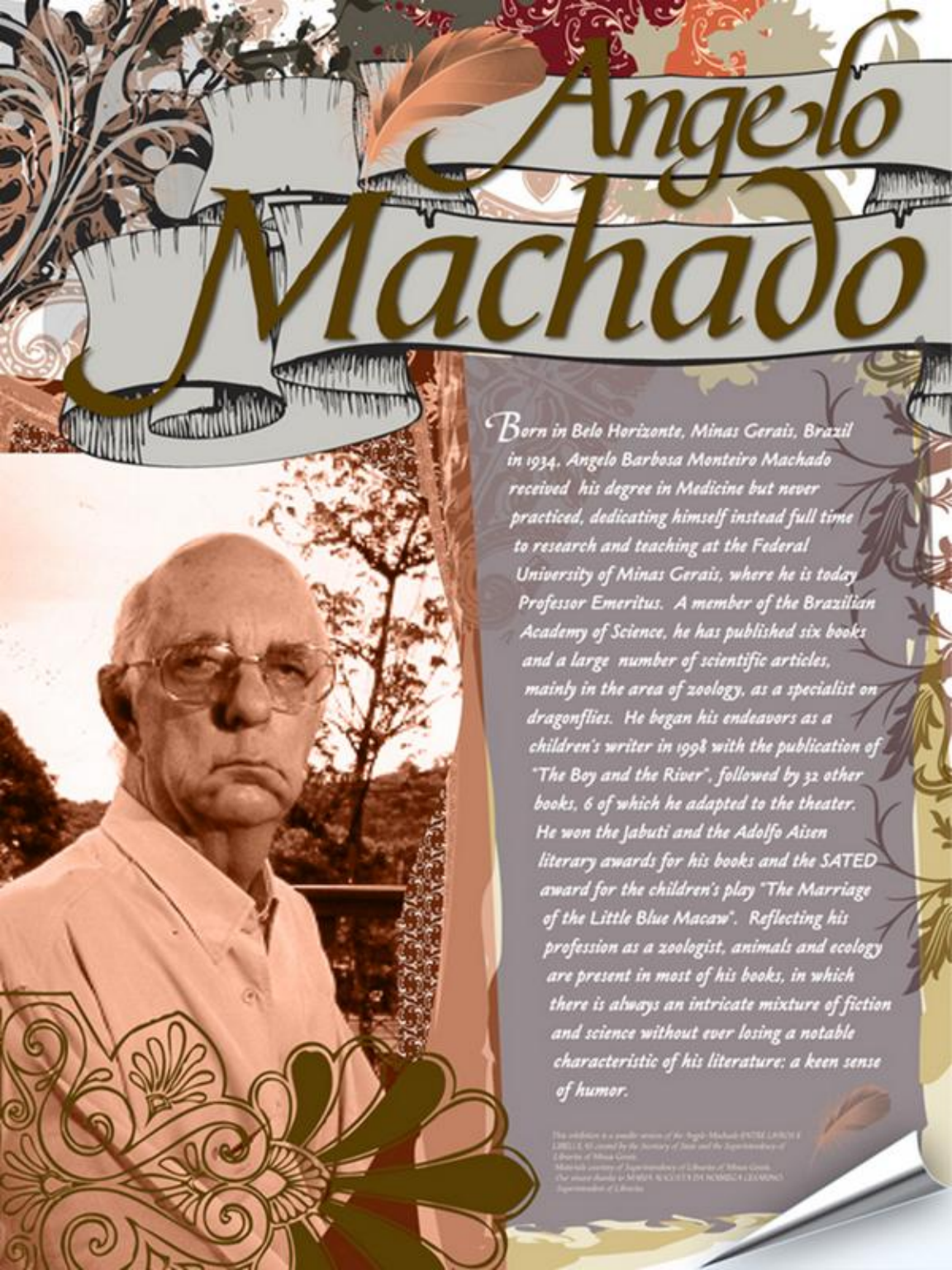




Angelo Machado



Born in Belo Horizonte, Minas Gerais, Brazil in 1934, Angelo Barbosa Monteiro Machado received his degree in Medicine but never practiced, dedicating himself instead full time to research and teaching at the Federal University of Minas Gerais, where he is today Professor Emeritus. A member of the Brazilian Academy of Science, he has published six books and a large number of scientific articles, mainly in the area of zoology, as a specialist on dragonflies. He began his endeavors as a children's writer in 1998 with the publication of "The Boy and the River", followed by 32 other books, 6 of which he adapted to the theater. He won the Jabuti and the Adolfo Aisen literary awards for his books and the SATED award for the children's play "The Marriage of the Little Blue Macaw". Reflecting his profession as a zoologist, animals and ecology are present in most of his books, in which there is always an intricate mixture of fiction and science without ever losing a notable characteristic of his literature: a keen sense of humor.
