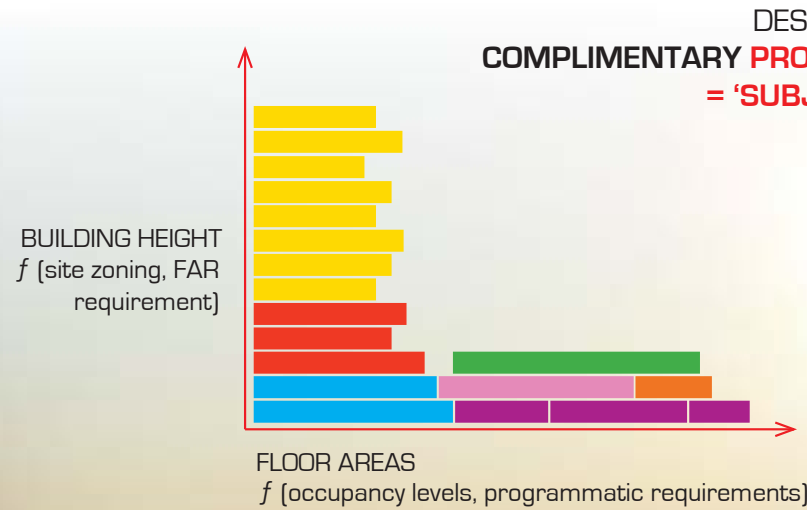


Site Analysis : Density



ContextThe site was an old parking lot near downtown Ann Arbor in a relatively dull & low density area. This project explores the concept of a 'subjective hybrid building' - programs driven by context & linked through symbiotic dependencies and shared intensities with each other. The programs vary from the highly prescriptive type through informal free public spaces. The diverse set of programs is so selected that they compliment one another creating a micro-ecology of internal dependencies and shared intensities of activities and uses. This mix of programs can allow for several unconventional and unexpected activities to occur. The goal was to create an arrangement of such spaces that foster a resilient micro-ecology (of economy and functions) of this web of inter-linked hybrid programs.
