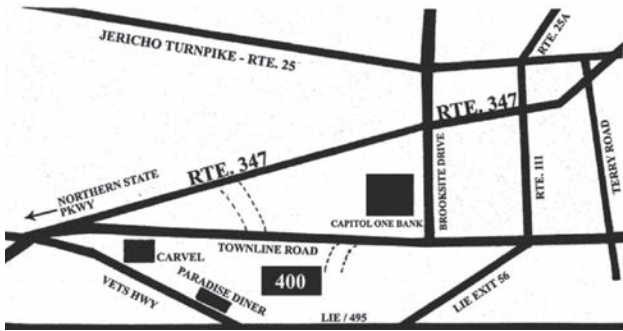

WHAT IS A DENTAL IMPLANT?

A dental implant is a small screw made of titanium, a material well-tolerated by the body. In order to replace the function of the tooth root, the dental implant is inserted in the jaw bone during a procedure that can be performed with a local anesthetic. The implant attaches to the bone and forms a solid anchor for the long-term attachment of the crown.

Conventional dentistry, such as crown and bridge, replaces just the crown – or part of the tooth above the gum. With a dental implant, the lost tooth root and the crown – the part below and above the gum – can be replaced. Your dental implant looks and feels just like your natural teeth.



With implants, there's no need to grind down healthy, adjacent teeth. The implant acts as a root to help prevent bone deterioration and delivers long lasting function and beauty.

WHY GET A DENTAL IMPLANT?

Dental implants are the best method of tooth replacement because they're the most like natural teeth. Dental implants are better than traditional bridges because they:

- help to prevent bone loss
- help keep other teeth from shifting out of place
- help prevent wearing on remaining teeth
- help prevent changes to your facial structure
- look beautiful and are a permanent solution

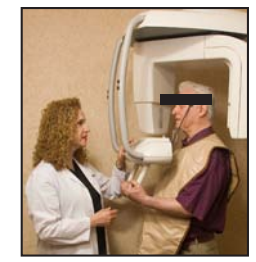
