**Ira Dickerman, CDT**, received his AAS in dental laboratory technology from Middlesex Community College in 1977. Having grown up at the laboratory bench, he went to work full time with his father, Myron J. Dickerman, CDT, upon his graduation. In 1984, he was in the unique position to fabricate the first endosseous hybrid prosthesis to be delivered in New England. Since that time, he and his dental laboratory team have had the opportunity to fabricate implant prosthodontics on all of the major dental implant systems in the marketplace. From single teeth to full arch milled bar reconstructions, he has treatment planned the restoration of thousands of implant units and reconstructions. Ira has lectured to countless implant study groups over the years and has participated in the training of many restorative dentists in implant reconstruction. He has spent a great deal of time in the dental operatory restoring implants with his restorative clients and has assisted at implant surgery in private and hospital settings as well.

# Esthetic Solutions for Implant Supported Restorations

## Course Description

This course is designed for the dental technician familiar with implant dentistry and the associated restorative components who desires to optimize esthetic and functional implant restorations. Emphasis will be placed on esthetic case planning, radiographic and surgical templates, soft tissue models, custom impression procedures, and abutment options.
