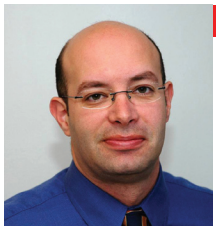


MONISH BHOLA, DDS, MSD

Associate Professor of Periodontology, he is currently the Director of Post-Graduate Periodontics, and Co-Director of Implant Dentistry at the UDM School of Dentistry and is a Diplomate of the American Board of

Periodontology. He earned his DDS from UDM and a MSD, Certificate in Periodontics, and Postdoctoral Fellowship in Implantology from Indiana University. He has several publications and abstracts in leading dental journals and has lectured extensively at the local, state and national levels and conducted several CE courses, which include advance periodontal and implant surgical courses using pig jaws and cadaver heads. In 2006, he won the prestigious Bud and Linda Tarrson Fellowship award given by the American Academy of Periodontology Foundation. Dr. Bhola also maintains a private practice limited to Periodontics and Implants in Waterford, Michigan.

Dr. Gurun completed a fellowship program in Prosthodontics at the University of Florida, College of Dentistry. He spent four years teaching as a full time faculty member there in the Department of Prosthetic Dentistry, also maintaining his faculty practice. Dr. Gurun joined the UDM Prosthodontic Department in 2001 and also received his U.S. DDS degree from the same institution. He has published both abstracts and articles mostly related to clinical techniques. He is also active in a number of professional associations.

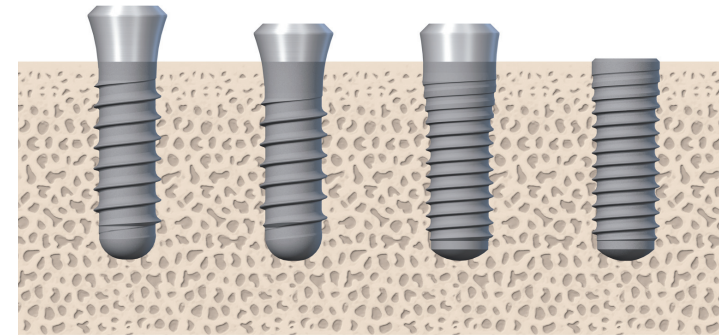

INCORPORATING SURGICAL PLANNING TOOLS FOR OPTIMAL IMPLANT THERAPY TREATMENTS



DESCRIPTION



This two day course emphasizes the integral surgical and prosthetic requirements for implant success. The course will consist of lectures and hands-on sessions for implant placement. Achieving optimal patient care through treatment planning with the entire dental team will be discussed at length. Discussions will also center around risk assessment and clinical evaluation of the implant site. The didactic portion of the course will focus on creating surgical guides for use in dental implant surgery, and dental implant placement on educational models and porcine specimens. Participants should obtain a comprehensive knowledge base for straight forward surgical implantation. The course is not intended to establish competency in placing dental implants, and expects participants to already be providing patient treatment.

OBJECTIVES

At the conclusion of the course, participants will be able to:

- Choose the appropriate implant and surgical treatment plan for implant procedures
- Utilize surgical guides in your dental implant practice
- Clinically evaluate the soft and hard tissue for the implant site
- Define patient selection criteria and risk assessment for dental implant surgery
