



Wooden “C”-shape units are placed in key areas of the apartment to help **define** each of the **spaces** (i.e. dining room, sitting room, bedroom, bathroom, and laundry room). The wood of the units **contrast** with the concrete flooring and pale plaster walls. Thin steel columns support the **“C”-shaped units** and are set towards the middle of the units, allowing the units to appear to be **floating**.
