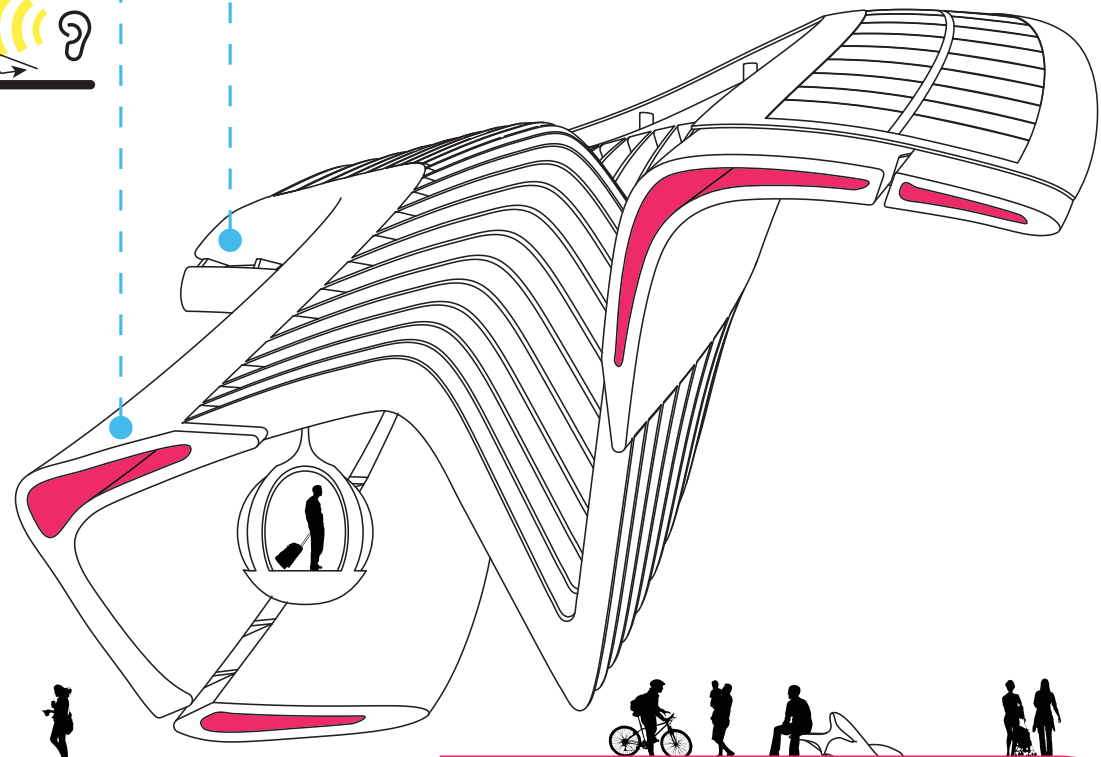
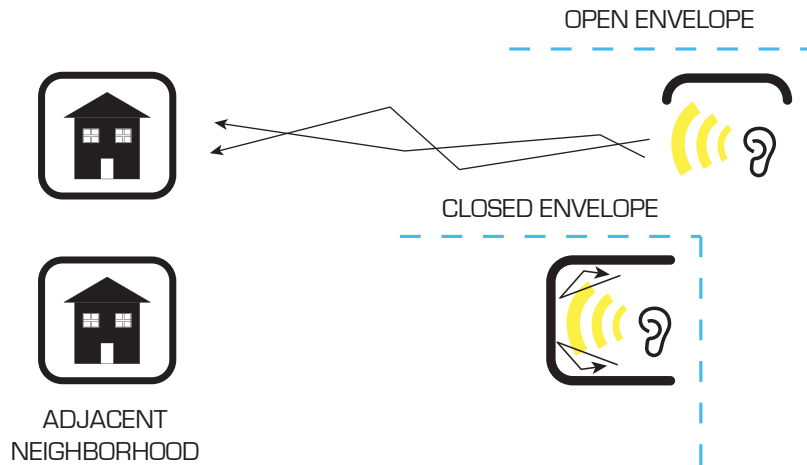


MORPHOLOGICAL STRUCTURE

The gondola transit's structure is a semi-monocoque shell which formally closes where the track touches the ground plane and stations are located in order to cut off the noise generated by the mechanical systems which feed the track line. As the track gains distance from the mechanical systems it opens up because of the lack of noise producing machines. On the opposing side facing the river the structure opens up to offer shade where urban furniture and sport facilities are situated.
