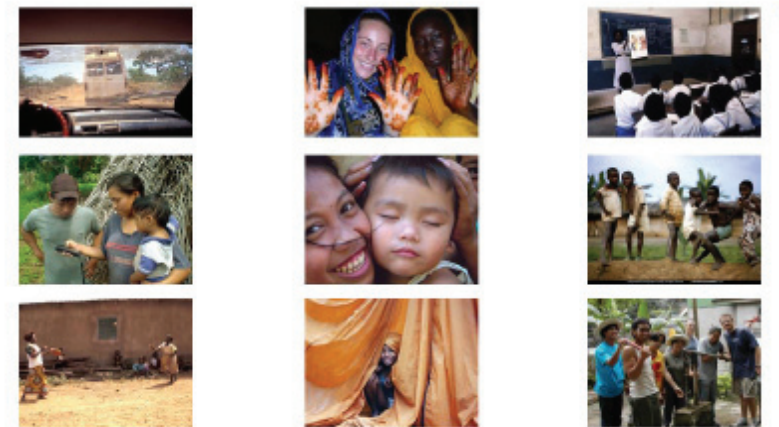

THE PEACE CORPS IS A FEDERAL AGENCY DEDICATED TO WORLD PEACE AND FRIENDSHIP. VOLUNTEERS SERVE THEIR COUNTRY IN THE CAUSE OF PEACE BY LIVING AND WORKING IN DEVELOPING COUNTRIES AND BRINGING THEIR SKILLS AND LIFE EXPERIENCES TO WHERE THEY ARE NEEDED THE MOST. ESTABLISHED IN 1961, THE PEACE CORPS NOW SERVES IN 73 COUNTRIES THROUGHOUT AFRICA, ASIA, THE CARIBBEAN, LATIN AMERICA, EUROPE AND THE MIDDLE EAST.
