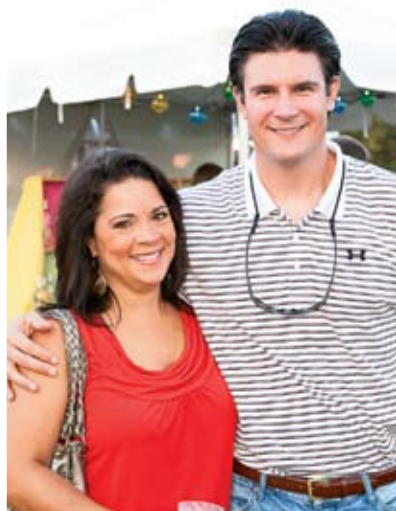
The Beach Ball August 28, 2010
