

Village of Rosemont, IL.

Rosemont was established in 1956, and is located between Chicago O'Hare International Airport and the City of Chicago. To date, the population is 4,000. Rosemont is a top meeting, convention, tradeshow and entertainment center, with an average of 50,000 visitors a day.

The village is approximately 2.5 square miles, and consists of 25% residential homes and 75% commercial/industrial Buildings, making Rosemont a predominately business orientated village.

In the year end of 2006, Rosemont had an average hotel occupancy rate of 70.1%. There are 5,230 total hotel rooms located in Rosemont. Being a predominately commercial village, it is safe to assume a lot of individuals will be traveling to Rosemont for business related activities, making the hotel industry profitable, and therefore competitive.
