

else. Kesha says on her Web site, "I want my music to be fun, unapologetic, rowdy, quirky, humorous, and interesting, but with substance behind it. I'm an emotional person underneath all my fronting. I want people to listen to it and feel like they can relate." Many of her songs tell a story relating to her own life and events. 'Kiss & Tell' is about how she found out her boyfriend was cheating on her with another pop starlet and 'Chain Reaction' is about the story surrounding a guy she met in a club.

Kesha's love for music began from the moment she was born. Her mother, Pebe, was a former punk-rock singer and songwriter who penned chart toppers for Joe Sun and Dolly Parton. Growing up in Nashville and with her mother's music career blooming once again, led her to being exposed to recording studios daily and attending a music school in Nashville. Pebe even let Kesha sing back-up vocals on tracks occasionally. Eventually, Kesha fell in love with the country greats – Johnny Cash, Dolly Parton and many others, not for the music style, but for the storytelling lyrics and emotion.

Kesha quit school at 17, although she was accepted to Columbia, and moved to L.A. where she met Music Producer Dr. Luke, who was currently collaborating with Flo Rida on a little song called, "Right Round." The female vocals you hear on the No. 1 song are Kesha's. She says when she first heard her voice on the radio, she was screaming and crying with joy that she had finally made it into mainstream music. "I'm working really hard to make this happen and it's nice to see that hard work pays off. I mean three years ago I was stealing canned vegetables from the dollar store to survive. Now I'm on a No. 1 song, working on my album, and have a little change in my pocket. To be able to take my mom out to dinner is the best feeling in the world," she says in her bio about being the vocalist in 'Right Round.'

Her own song 'Tik Tok' was on the record charts as No. 1 for a record-breaking time period and she released her debut album 'Animal' on January 1, 2010. Kesha was working on her album for seven years and wrote every song. Look for a national tour soon featuring this new, beautiful and talented starlet.<

Patients with Poland Syndrome, a rare, congenital condition where one of the pec muscles is missing, often have poor breast development or even absence of a breast on the affected side.

Breasts are seldom exactly symmetrical, but in some women there is a noticeable difference in size, causing clothes to fit awkwardly.

Pregnancy and aging also contribute to the breasts being uneven or asymmetrical. Often patients will come to my office thinking they need a breast lift after pregnancy, when they actually would benefit from implants.

We've come a long way since the 1890s, when breast augmentation consisted of injecting paraffin into the breasts.
