



Phase Two: Toxin Extraction

The toxins from the mold exist in the air, but they perpetuate themselves by hiding in the porous cave walls. The extraction process involves shoving perforated cones that are attached to drainage veins into the cave walls, and then wiggling to induce a suction effect that drains the contaminated moisture through the perforated cones, through the drainage veins, and then down into the interior hydrowheel chamber.
