List of Available Programs

BODY SAFETY

30-45 minutes, PK thru 5th grade

A fun and interactive program that discusses appropriate and inappropriate touches, secrets and what to do in uncomfortable situations.

PERSONAL SAFETY

45 minutes, 6th grade through 8th

This is a combined program that includes sexual harassment, date rape and body safety. Definitions of flirting, harassment, and safety strategies are discussed.



SELF ESTEEM

1 hour, 4th grade thru adult

Our self esteem curriculum is based on self confidence, positive thinking, random acts of kindness and self image. A series of 1 to 6 lessons can be tailored to your needs.

INFORMATIONAL BOOTHS

All Ages

We encourage you to contact us for community events (health fairs, school/college open houses, safety day events, etc.) to set up a booth. We are always pleased to meet community members, distribute information and talk about our free services.

INTERNET SAFETY

45 minutes, 1st thru 12th grade

A program designed to teach students the importance of keeping personal information safe, dangers online and real life consequences.



BULLYING

45 minutes, PreK-12th grade

This program is an interactive discussion about different types of bullying, laws, what to do in particular situations and the important role of bystanders.

RAPE AWARENESS

1 hour, 8th grade thru adult

This presentation provides participants with a greater knowledge about rape through statistics, laws, date rape drugs, medical exams and personal safety.

ADDITIONAL SERVICES

We are also available to do trainings with professionals (teachers, hospital staff, law enforcement, etc.) and community groups.



SEXTING

45 minutes, 7th grade thru adult

This program defines what sexting is and discusses possible personal and legal consequences.
