

Temperature & Light

The Flamingo flower is a humid climate flower. It is best to grow this plant in the proper temperature of between sixty to eighty-five degree inside a shaded area.

Potting

The flamingo flower is best grown in a soil mixed with peat moss, perlite, pine bark or gravel in a medium size pot with hole at the bottom.

Best soil to use is an African violet mixture.

Watering

In the summer time it is best to drench the soil with water and let it dry slightly with warm water. And be sure that you don't let the plant sit in a tray of water for too long, orchids do not like their feet wet.
