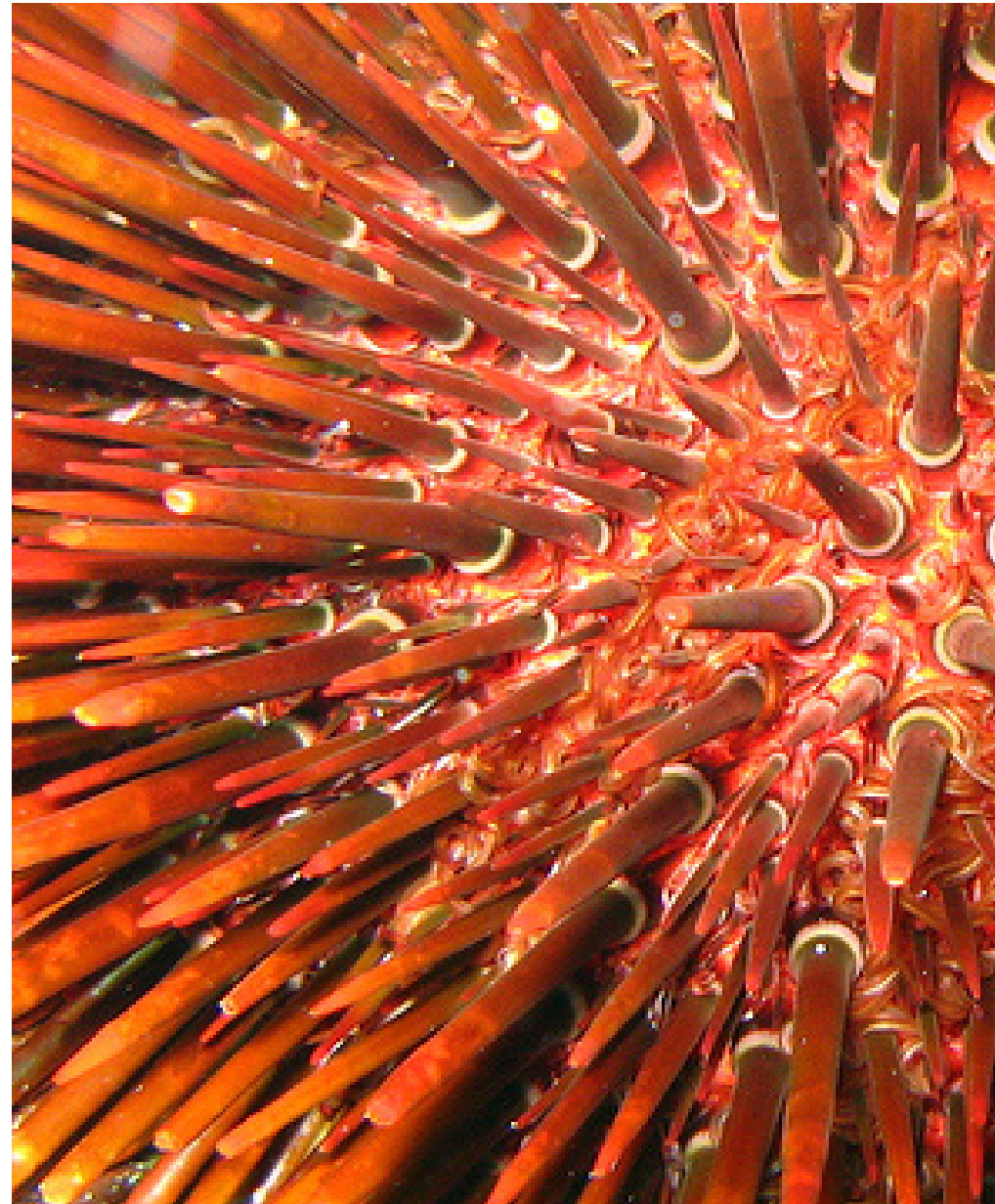

**Why:** It is beautiful and goes all the way back to Vitruvius.



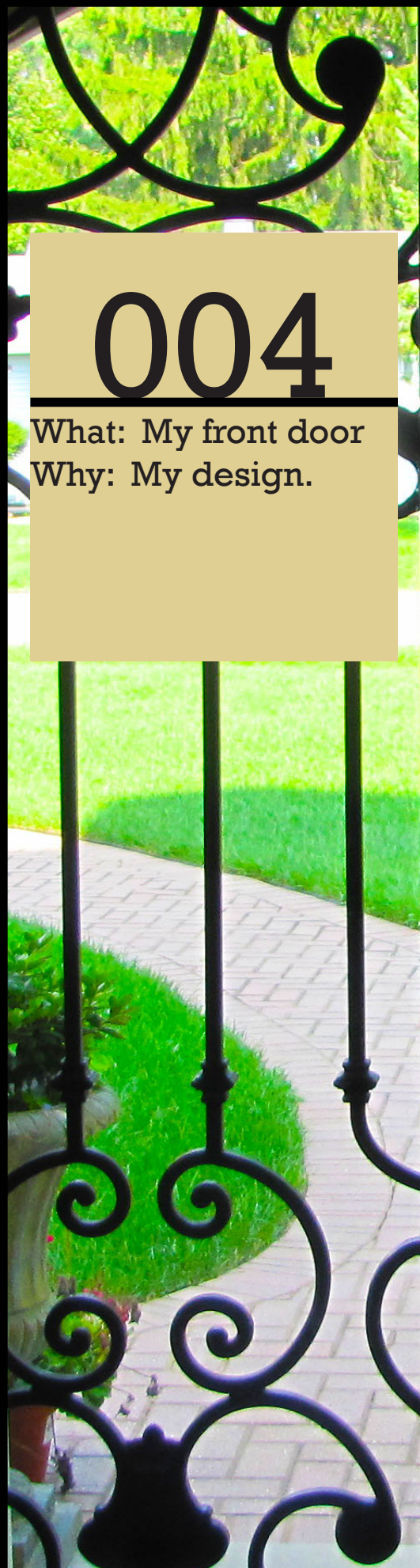
