Seating Solutions for High School Performing Arts Center and Lecture Room

Lincoln-Sudbury Regional High School, Sudbury, MA, was designed as a state-of-the-art, energy efficient building by noted local architects OMR (The Office of Michael Rosenfeld). The project required the construction of a performing arts center and for the construction of a steeply sloping lecture room. OMR requested the involvement of *Theatre Solutions* (TSI) early in the design process, and TSI was able to provide a chair that would satisfy the requirements for both rooms.

The model selected, the Acclaim C3, features fully-upholstered seats, backs, and end panels. The auditorium included 695 chairs of different seat widths with frames engineered to accommodate a sloped floor

and, on the mezzanine level, riser-mounted frames. ADA compliant chairs as well as removable chairs were required. Options included low-voltage aisle lights and aisle/row tags. The 117 chair lecture room, also furnished with Acclaim C3 chairs, required the use of riser-mount frames and retractable tablet arms.

The architect and building committee took into account several concerns in the selection of the auditorium seating, including adaptability and durability. A product constructed of the highest-quality materials, with no parts to fatigue and eventually fail, a chair with zippered replaceable seat covers to increase product life, and

riser-mounted frames to enable efficient cleaning was preferable. A silent seat tip-up was critical for acoustical success in the performing arts center. The Acclaim also has an envelope of just 15 in., giving the greatest density of chairs per sq. ft. And the TSI/Acclaim lifetime warranty insures many years of trouble-free performance.
