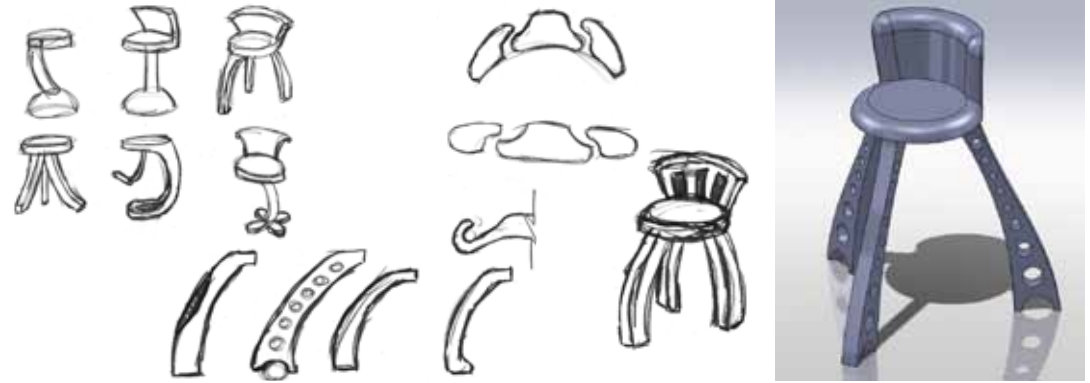


The objective was to design a personal translation of a “Perch” into a furniture piece.



What I wanted the Stool to do:

- Have the stool be taller than average stools.
- Have the Seat be angled.
- Use only three legs.

The stool could be made with any material, this one was made with Baltic Birch Plywood.

The extra height was to create a sense of temporary seating similar to a bird perching up high.

The seat was designed to ever so slightly angle the user out of the chair giving the sense of a short term seating spot.

The choice to use only three legs was for aesthetics; the holes in the legs were for aesthetic design and to reduce the weight.
