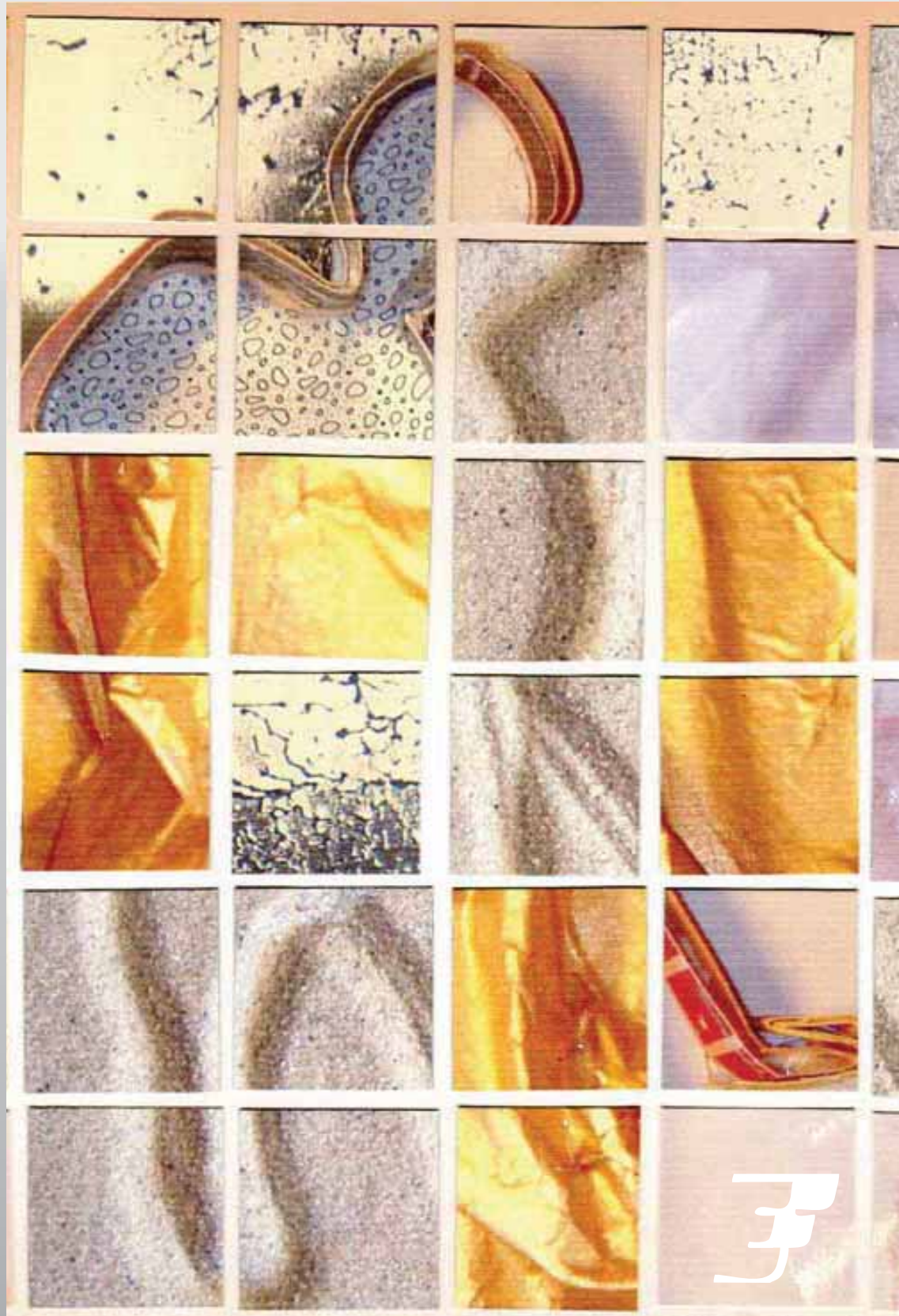


No yellow bellies here
