Our dedicated and responsible camp staff are carefully selected for their skills, experience, and interest in working with children. They are excellent role models and mentors and bring creativity and enthusiasm to camp every day. All staff receive extensive training prior to the summer and ongoing supervision during the summer to ensure they are providing the highest quality care for all children. In addition, all staff are trained in creative programming, group dynamics, child development, conflict resolution, safety procedures and more.

JEWISH VALUES AT CAMP

Jewish values are an integral part of your child's JCC summer camp experience:

- Singing Ruach (spirit) every morning.
- Participating in tikkun olam (repairing the world) through service projects.
- Performing mitzvot (acts of kindness) during the camp day.
- Learning the importance of Tzedakah (charity) through a camp-wide fundraiser for the Charity of the Summer.
- Celebrating the Sabbath every Friday morning.

COMMUNICATION

Communication is very important at JCC Summer Camp. All important information about camp activities will be emailed. In addition, photos will be uploaded to the JCC Louisville Summer Camp Facebook page at least twice a week. If a specific situation arises with a particular camper, parents will be notified by camp staff. All camp staff is available during the entire summer to answer questions generally about the programs or specifically about a child or situation. Specific information about camps will be posted on the website jewishlouisville.org/camp.

SPECIAL NEEDS CHILDREN

JCC Summer Camp programs will accommodate children with special needs who are ready to be mainstreamed in a group camp experience at the discretion of the Camp Director. One-on-one advocates are welcome at camp. It is each family's responsibility to provide and fund your camper's advocate. We reserve the right to recommend alternative summer programs.

CAMP CONDUCT POLICY

Every effort will be made by staff to ensure a positive camp experience for your children. In the event that there are behavioral difficulties which are deemed irreconcilable, children may be removed from any JCC summer program either in part or in full. Availability of refunds, partial or full, will be determined by Center staff.

SWIMMING AT CAMP!

GET UP GANG (16 months - 5TH grade)

Supervised activities and games before camp.

June 13 - August 12

7:30 a.m. - 9:00 a.m.

Fee per week: \$25 | Member fee per week: \$20

STAY 'N PLAY (Kindergarten - 5TH grade)

Camp fun continues with organized games, arts and crafts and other activities. All participants receive a snack.

Fee per week: \$70 | Member fee per week: \$55

INSTRUCTIONAL SWIM

- All swim instructors are certified lifeguards with experience teaching American Red Cross swim lessons.
- Campers learn the four basic strokes and breathing techniques as well as aquatic safety.
- Lessons include water games which teach swimming and are used as instructional tools.
- All lessons are supervised vigilantly by the lifeguard on duty as well as by the swim instructors.

CAMP J-TOTS (2-4 Years)

- Group lessons three days a week for 30 minutes.
- Campers are taught in groups of four based on swimming skill ability.

CAMP KEFF (Grades K-3)

- Group lessons five days a week for 30 minutes.
- Campers are taught in groups of six based on swimming skill ability.

FREE SWIM

CAMP J-TOTS (2-4 Years)

- Free swim in baby pool two days a week.
- Campers are supervised by a certified lifeguard and by camp staff.

CAMP KEFF, TREK 46, TWEEN & TEEN, SPECIALTY AND SPORTS CAMPS

- Free swim five days a week in the afternoon.
- The first day of each session campers are swim tested and receive a colored wristband that designates what section of the pool they are allowed to swim in.
- Campers are supervised by certified lifeguards, camp staff and the camp swim supervisor.

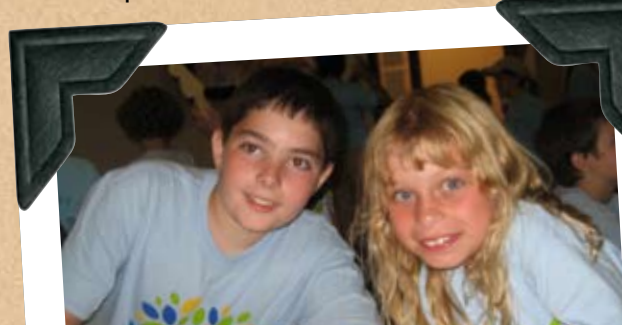

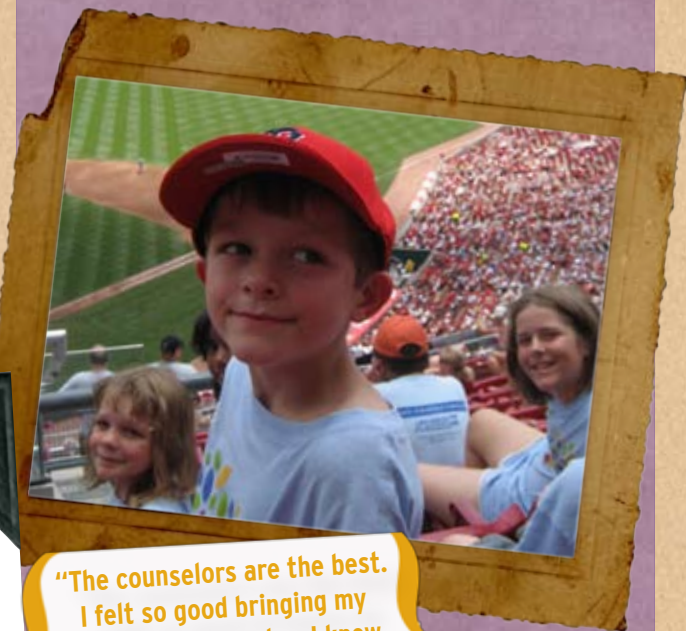

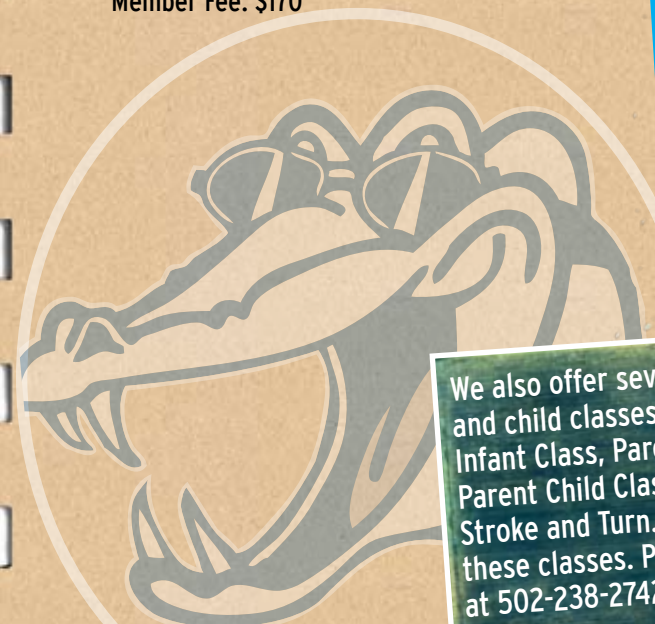
