

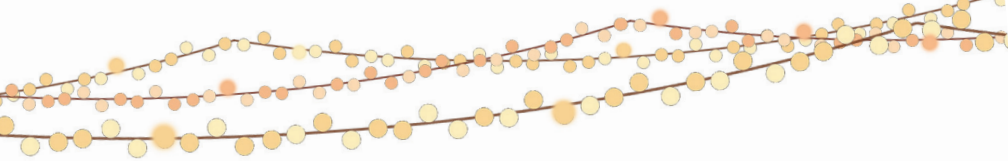

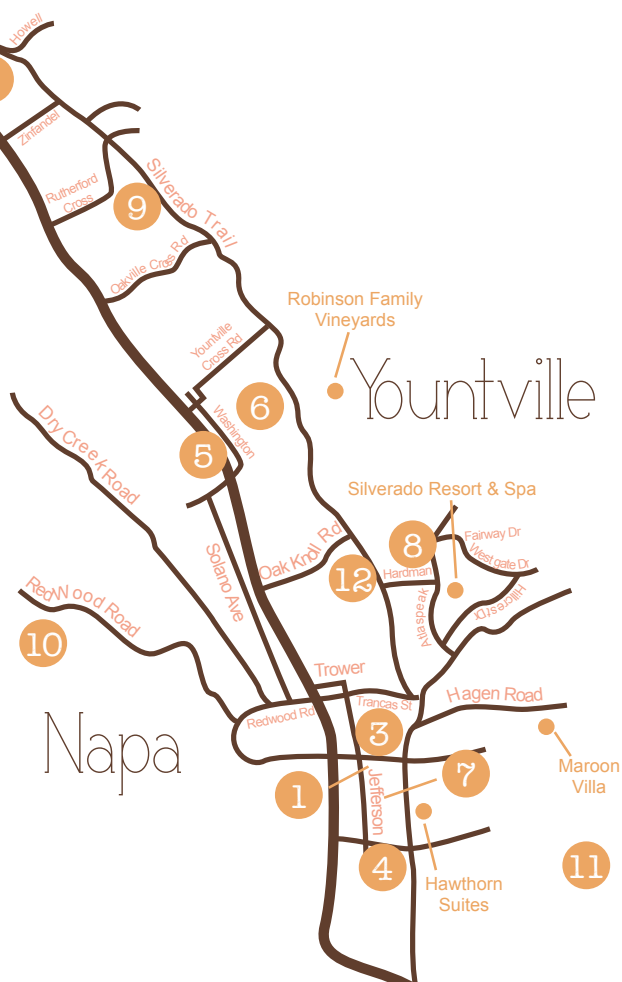


To Our Friends and Family

1 BOUNTY HUNTER WINE BAR AND SMOKIN BBQ (\$\$)

975 First Street | Napa | 11am-10pm (until midnight Fri/Sat)

Great low key restaurant nearby in downtown Napa for lunch or dinner. If you head to Bounty Hunter, you must try the Beer Can Chicken! Has a great wine and beer selection, good for a snack or full meal. One of our favorites!

2 TRA VIGNE (\$\$\$)

1050 Charter Oak Avenue | St. Helena | 11:30am-9:30pm

This is a bit of a drive up the valley to St. Helena, but totally worth it for some amazing Italian food. Make sure you try their Rosemary Pizzetta and homemade Mozzarella. It will change your life.

3 CA MONI ENOTECA IN OXBOW MARKET (\$\$)

610 First Street | Napa | 7:30am-9pm

Located near downtown Napa, this is the best pizza in town (and there is a lot of good pizza!). They serve wine by the liter, have a great patio, and when you are done eating Prociutto Pizza you can walk around the rest of Oxbow to check out the other vendors (and dessert!) One of the more 'affordable' places to eat.



4 IN AND OUT (\$)

820 W Imola Avenue | Napa | 10:30am-1am

There are a ton between the airport and Napa, but incase you get to Napa and haven't stopped, this is the closest (in the Home Depot parking lot!). Make sure to google all the secret orders you can place. Best never-frozen-fast-food hamburger you'll ever have.

5 BOTTEGA (\$\$\$)

6525 Washington Street | Yountville | 11:30-3pm and 5-9:30pm

Located in Yountville (where most of the fancy restaurants are), this Michael Chiarello restaurant is amazing. It was the chosen spot for Jen's 30th birthday and our TwoYear Anniversary. Everything on the menu is glorious. Everything. You'll most likely need reservations.

6 BOUCHON BAKERY (\$)

6528 Washington Street | Yountville | 7am-7pm

Owned by Thomas Keller (same as French Laundry), you can smell the tasty pastries a mile away. Great place for coffee and breakfast snack after the previous day's wine tasting. It will also give you a chance to stroll by French Laundry's personal garden and the actual restaurant.

7 NAPA GENERAL STORE (\$\$)

540 Main Street | Napa | 8am-4pm

Great stop for breakfast and is attached to a cute shop to take a look around. They have a patio overlooking the river and mimosas. Right in the heart of downtown, good place to start and then stroll down the street for a relaxing morning.

8 WILLIAM HILL

1761 Atlas Peak Road | Napa

This is our favorite place to visit when we are in Napa. They have a gorgeous view of the valley with comfy chairs. We have spent hours here, it is quintessential relaxing Napa. Usually we just get a bottle versus a tasting and enjoy the outdoors. Not the fanciest wine, but by far the best view!

9 MUMM NAPA

8445 Silverado Trail | Rutherford

This winery serves mostly bubbly wine (like champagne) which is awesome. Swing by here for an excuse to go somewhere before noon. They have a great selection of bubbly you never knew existed, try the flight and you will really taste the difference. Gorgeous view and a great place to hang out for a bit.

10 HESS COLLECTION

4411 Redwood Road | Napa

Up the valley, Hess has a very long history and started making wine for the church. The monks still live next door and you can see vines from 75+ years ago. This is a great spot to take a tour of the production, they have an art gallery and the wine is pretty affordable.



11 PORTER FAMILY VINEYARDS

1189 Green Valley Road | Napa

This winery is set on the hill side and most of the production takes place in a maze of caves. You definitely need an appointment ahead of time to go here. It's a small family-run winery with lots of great stories (and two cute dogs!) Digging the cave was a Dirtiest Jobs episode with Mike Rowe!

12 BLACK STALLION

4089 Silverado Trail | Napa

Right of the Silverado Trail when coming from town, Black Stallion is where we almost got married! They have a beautiful tasting room and grounds, not to mention some great wine. Swing by here when you have an hour between events and enjoy the outdoor patio (you can even try grapes off the vines!)

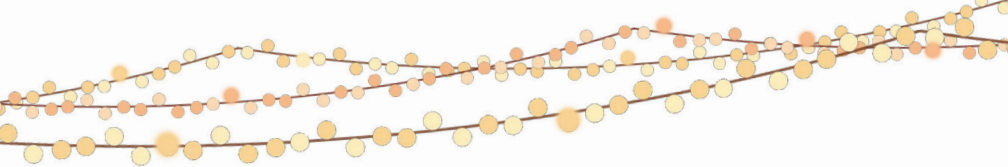

Once you pass Stag's Leap Winery on the right, take the second right -- there is a post at the end of the road that shows all the address numbers up the road. 5880 is listed on one of the red signs. Come up the road and you will be able to park in the lot or along the driveway.

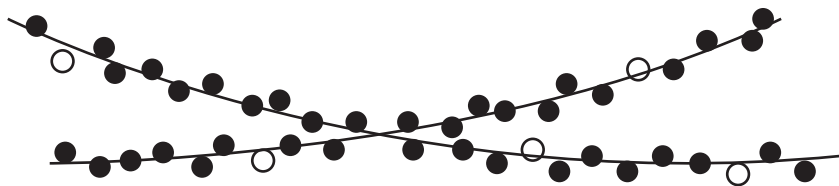
