## **Artist: Eli Lipman**

Eli began blowing glass as a sophomore in high school. He was taught by Robin Schultes at the Toledo Museum of Art. His high school had a unique program called Winterim which is a month long period in which students can study subjects independently. During this time Eli studied with Master Glassblower, Leonard Marty from TMA, Jack Schmidt, Shawn Messenger, Robin Schultes and Matt Paskiet. This was an experience that could never be replicated for Eli. During the fall of 2008 Eli attended his first semester at Salem Community College in their scientific program. Eli states, "When I make glass, I attempt to capture the movement and flow of the medium. This is why I enjoy the stretched out vessels created by Italian glass Maestro Lino Tagliapietra.
