Making water twice as nice

Sending nearly clean water down household drains is a waste. Reusing water saves twice because you draw less water from your well or municipal water system, and you dump less water into your septic tank or sewage system. Water that you've used to do dishes, laundry or bathe may be considered reusable greywater. Even though it might contain soap, grease or even food particles, you generally can reuse it for a variety of household purposes.

Greywater collection and filtration systems that range from simple to elaborate are becoming more available, though regulations for these vary widely from state to state. Many people use greywater to water lawns, trees and gardens. Here are some tips for using greywater for irrigation from the New Mexico State University Cooperative Extension office:

- Pour greywater directly onto the soil and avoid any contact with any part of the plants themselves.
- Root vegetable plants that produce crops you eat raw should not be watered with greywater.
- Because greywater tends to be alkaline, it shouldn't be used on plants that prefer acidic soil.
- Use greywater to irrigate mature and well-established plants, but not on seedlings or immature plants.
- Dilute greywater with fresh water, and don't use greywater in a small, concentrated patch of ground.
- Only use greywater in flat areas where it is unlikely to run off from the space you're watering.
- Try to use greywater the same day you collect it. Saving the water for more than a day can allow bacteria to develop.
