













You will take a left at the exit and follow the county park signs. You will drive through the town of Merlin, pass three rafting outfitters and continue approximately 4 more miles. You will see a big asphalt parking lot on your left that is Hog Creek Boat Landing.

Please be sure to pay the \$4 Josephine County parking fee. There is a pay station by the outhouses.

Park up top and walk down to the river.

Afternoon half-day Rogue River raft trips meet at Galice, located 8 miles past Hog Creek Boat Landing. See directions above.
