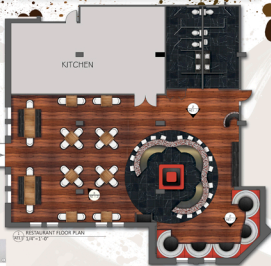
Coast Fusion restaurant combines the fresh, unique flavors of the Caribbean with the modern, upscale menu of Japanese cuisine. This was the basis for the design concept. The goal was to experience the tropical sensation while still looking contemporary and slick.

Use of minimal color scheme emphasized the modern look of the space with splashes of a bold, vibrant color to enhance the look. There are many different textures which provide a break in the space and help to enhance the flow of the space. The circulation is much larger than code because of the use of the larger dining chairs.

Influences from up to date restaurants and the sultry look of natural, tropical scenes helped decide the furniture of the space. The use of natural wood that is stained to black to correspond with the other energetic colors yet it still works well with the natural materials.

Emphasis placed onto the sushi bar was enhanced with the use of a unique countertop and different seating to separate it from the rest of the restaurant. Also, the change of flooring helped to isolate this part to create a distinction between the dining area and the sushi bar area.

For this project, I was required to take an existing site and design a space for the use as a restaurant. The requirements were to have seating for at least 86 occupants and lounge seating for 50 and a bar area with a seating minimum of 6. I was also required to include one wait station. There must also be lobby seating for 6 that will be placed adjacent to a hostess stand. This space must also meet the ADA and IBC code requirements for the A2 occupancy. This 3,800 square foot restaurant was designed using influences from asian style and sushi restaurants and menus.
