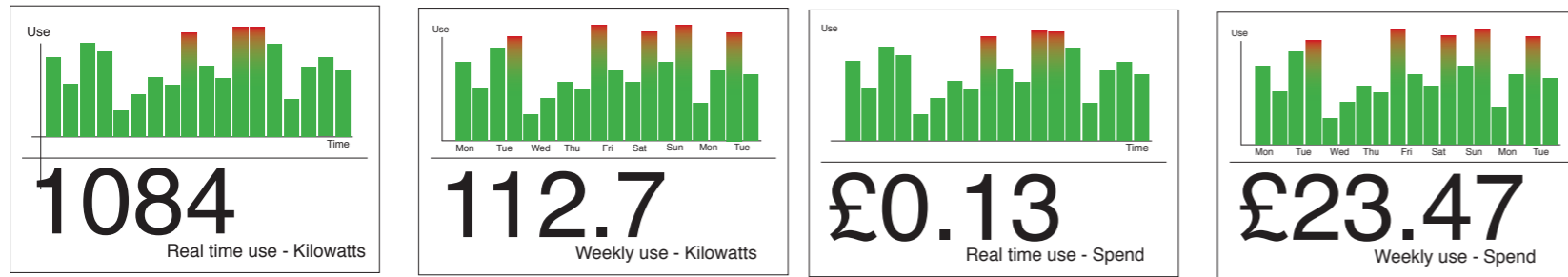


# Re-Design - Information

## Display and Information



Using controls for changing display, you can choose between current consumption or spend as well as a graphical representation of whether usage is up or down, again for spend or consumption

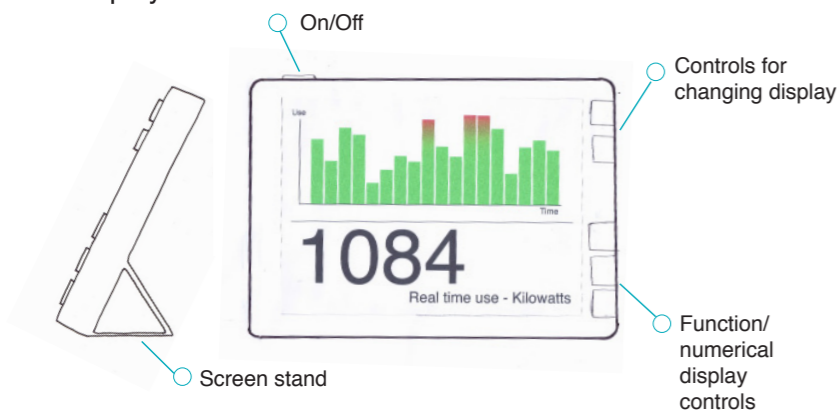
In addition, you can display consumption or spend as a weekly format. Again, the option of changing both graphical and numerical display is available using the buttons down the right hand side

By representing use graphically, you gain an instant picture of whether your usage is high or low, as well as being able to see if something has been left on. The graph will spike and fade to red when consumption is high.

## Loading tariff

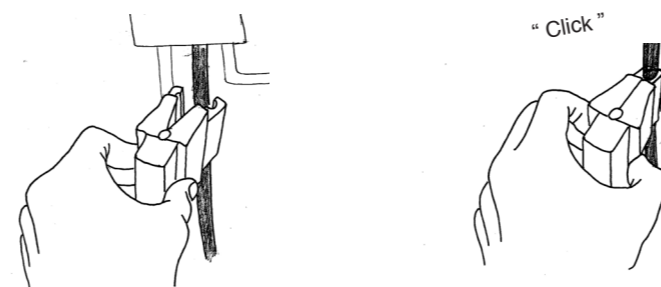
By entering your **supplier, age and tariff**, the meter will make **adjustments** on your **behalf**, reducing the stress for the user and increasing the accuracy of the readings. The software is set up so that you cannot progress to one screen without completing the task on the current one, creating a more linear set up process. ## Your display



Your device comes pre loaded with basic information from major energy providers.  
By inputting your supplier, age and major tariff, the device will automatically adjust for cheaper tariffs and age related discounts.

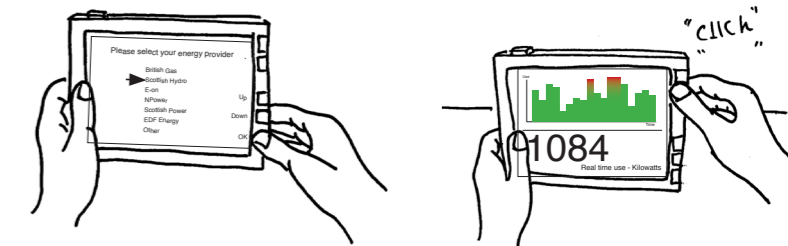
## Attach the electricity sensor clip to the live electrical main



Press sides to open and clip around cable.  
Live usually identified by brown or red label.

Clip will click when closed around cable.  
Light on clip will only light green when clip is enclosed around live cable

## Now, read your personal energy tariff from your bill



Use buttons on the right to select your energy provider and follow on screen instructions.  
Top 6 are listed, if your provider is not listed, your device will approximate your tariff discount

Please input necessary data before using the buttons down the side to select which display suits you best. This can be changed at any time using these buttons.

## Instructions

The instructions have had a major overhaul. By depicting each step graphically with a couple of supporting lines underneath, the user can visualise where they are along the process, making it much easier to follow. The parts are also drawn and identified so that the user can lay them out and make sure everything is correct before they start set up. This reduces the overall cognitive burden on the user and the use of helpful hints as well as friendly language personalises the product. Full instructions Appendix F
