Currently within the Cleveland Warehouse District at West 9th and Main Street lie two parking lots and an over-pass. However, On July 22nd, 1796 Moses Cleveland stood on the shore of Lake Erie with renowned surveyor Seth Pease. Continuing their survey of the Connecticut Land Company's Western Reserve, They surveyed the land before them with the vision of Cleveland in mind. In that spot a unique tree was designated, and came to be known as the Cleveland Witness Tree; a tree that grew tall for generations in commemoration of witnessing the birth of our city. Sadly, the tree has since been removed and now asphalt is all that remains.
