

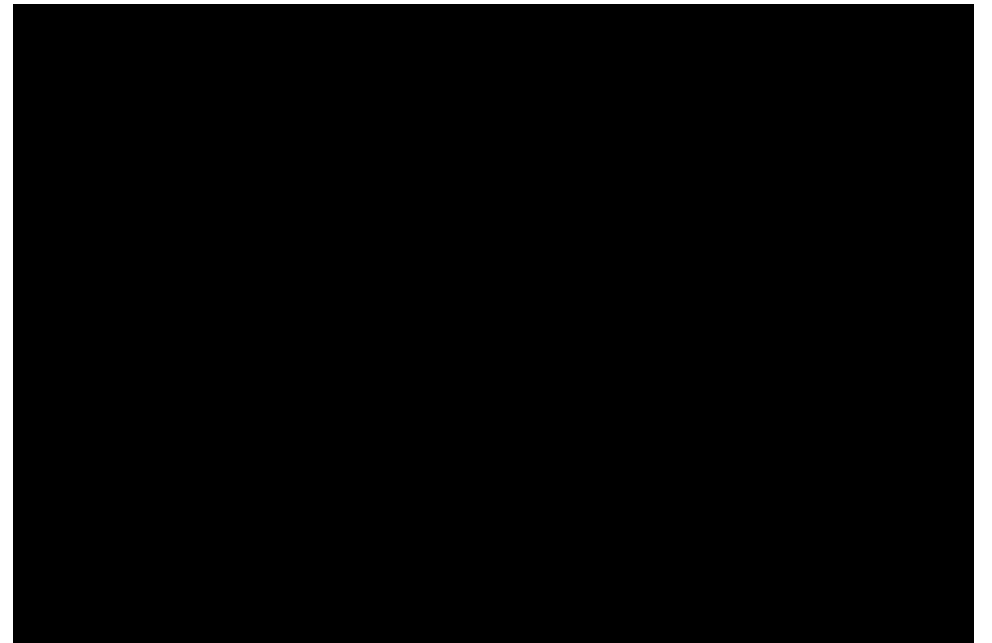

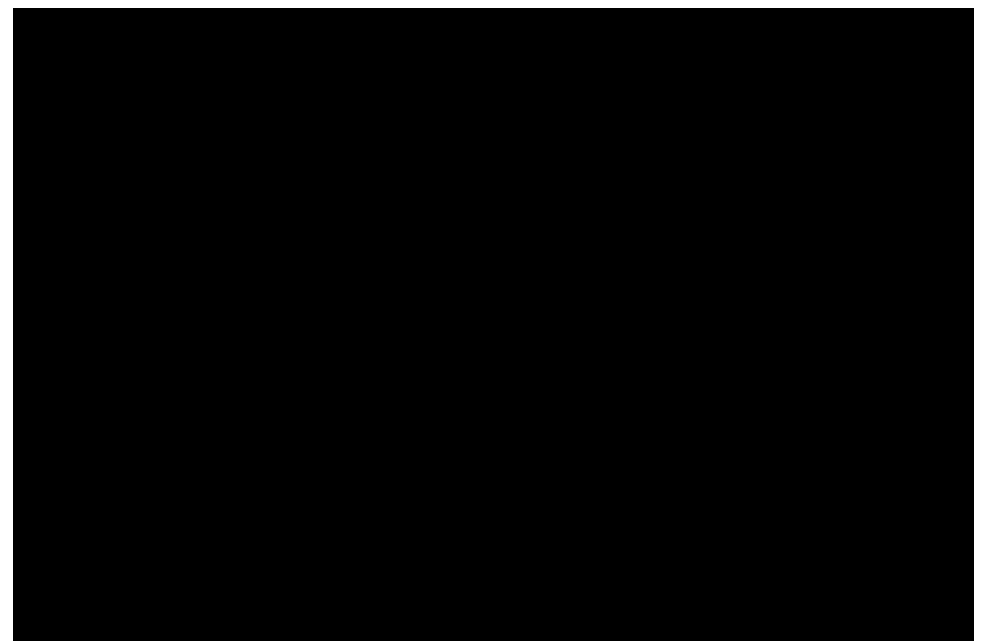
## Assessment of DWU
