red light flicks off and then woman dressed in red.


trick: red light lingers in audience's mind for 100 milliseconds after light flickers, during which her dress is removed revealling red dress



the brain uses neural tricks to build a shorthand reality, instantaneously choosing what to see and drop. "magic exposes the inseams, the neural stitching in the perpetual curtain"



Wobbled spoon looks curved because end-stopped neurons in visual cortex respond differently to the other motion-sensing cells and the slight difference warps the edges of where the spoon is



#### inattentional blindness movie



focusing on scene means many don't see the gorilla in the room

intermittent conditioning is the best way to maintain trick...lead audience to believe they've figured it out then change the trick

perception is surpsingly narrow and relatively little of sensory clamor makes its way to awareness

"look, I can make a coin appear in the bucket" people look for patterns even when they are not there, so will mismatch cause and effect, to form a false hypothesis over and over. coin in hand holding bucket, but by alternating bucket between hands, audience will not realize

sleights of mind

texting is the new trend in illegal border crossing

smugglers guide illegal immigrants with cues from cell phones

new controversial cell phone app to help guide illegal immigrants to water stations and safe zones



compartments don't open unless specific sequence of events occurs ex. pump brakes while turning on radio and dome light


